

# Le Star Walker Stars in his 4th ABTA Championship 3-6-9 will be \$1,800 at West Covina, and Match Series Estimated at \$950

Match Game estimated at \$1,200 · ABTA at West Covina for 1 Day Event

WESTMINSTER-We returned to Westminster Lanes and their friendly staff where we saw 156 entries come out and support the ABTA. We had a rather easy shot making the cut scores of +111 for the men and +51 for the women. The Super Seniors added to the board (2 men and 1 female) were Jack Trongale (+86) Bud Zagorski (+77) and no super senior female as both made the regular cut. Super Seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 44 bowlers making it to the semi-finals at Westminster.

Top Qualifiers were Shaun Suase with a +200. For the women it was Carla Sanchez with a +118. They will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Our top seed Shawn had the honor of drawing the Match Series. It was worth \$568 Shawn drew a 668. We had no bowlers that bowled this score, so we will estimate the Match Series at \$950 at West Covina Saturday. The last bowler for the 3-6-9 roll-off this week was Mike J Moore. He needed to get five 9 counts or strikes to take home \$1,700 this week. Mike was not able to make it missing on shot two. So he took home a consolation of \$50. We will add \$100 to the pot, and it will be \$1,800 this week at West

In our optional doubles, finishing in first were Chris Abing and "the Coiffeur" Minh Dang with a 1547 for \$100. Finishing second was Minh Dang and Le Star Walker with 1542 for \$80. There was a total of \$800 paid out in doubles and 18 paid spots with low to cash of 1465.

That would bring us to the semi-finals where 42 bowlers took to the floor at Westminster. There were 2 bowlers who did not show for the semi-finals. This week we had Beat the Board Finals due to another event that eve and the Super Bowl on Sunday. In our Beat the Board "where you finish is Your Paycheck", the ABTA guarantees \$100 min for the top 16 finishers. Three women are guaranteed to the top 16. Before the semi-finals started, everyone had a chance to pick the bowler who would finish on top this week in our weekly horses. 


