Tish Johnson Wins \$10,000 at WBA/ABT Las Vegas Event

LAS VEGAS — Tish Johnson of Colorado Springs, CO. won the 1st National Women's Bowling Alliance (WBA) event hosted by the Amateur Bowlers Tour (ABT) Winter Nationals at South Point Lanes, Las Vegas, NV. by topping 90 entries of the best women bowlers in the U.S. for a \$10,000 payday.

Bryanna Caldwell of Red Rock, AZ led all 3 game semi-finalists shooting 807, Tammy Turner, N. Ogden, UT was second with 773 and

third was Cassandra Leuthold, Black Hills, SD and Tish was the last bowler to make the Top 4 match play finals with a 728. Tish averaged 247 in the semi-finals and match play finals with a record of 3-1 for the title.

Both Caldwell & Leuthold dazzled the crowd by both shooting a 300 game on the same pair during the second game of semi-finals. 16 year old Makayla Douglas of Sandy, OR just missed the semi-finals by 7 pins by rolling a 721,

but everyone witnessed many more great things are to come from such a young talented bowler. And this is exactly why the WBA was formed, to showcase the talented female athletes!

3-6-9 will be \$1,800 at West Covina, and Match Series Estimated at \$950

Match Game estimated at \$1,200 • ABTA at West Covina for 1 Day Event

WESTMINSTER—We returned to Westminster Lanes and their friendly staff where we saw 156 entries come out and support the ABTA. We had a rather easy shot making the cut scores of +111 for the men and +51 for the women. The Super Seniors added to the board (2 men and 1 female) were Jack Trongale (+86) Bud Zagorski (+77) and no super senior female as both made the regular cut. Super Seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 44 bowlers making it to the semi-finals at Westminster.

Top Qualifiers were Shaun Suase with a +200. For the women it was Carla Sanchez with a +118. They will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Our top seed Shawn had the honor of drawing the Match Series. It was worth \$568. Shawn drew a 668. We had no bowlers that bowled this score, so we will estimate the Match Series at \$950 at West Covina Saturday. The last bowler for the 3-6-9 roll-off this week was Mike J Moore. He needed to get five 9 counts or strikes to take home \$1,700 this week. Mike was not able to make it missing on shot two. So he took home a consolation of \$50. We will add \$100 to the pot, and it will be \$1,800 this week at West Covina.

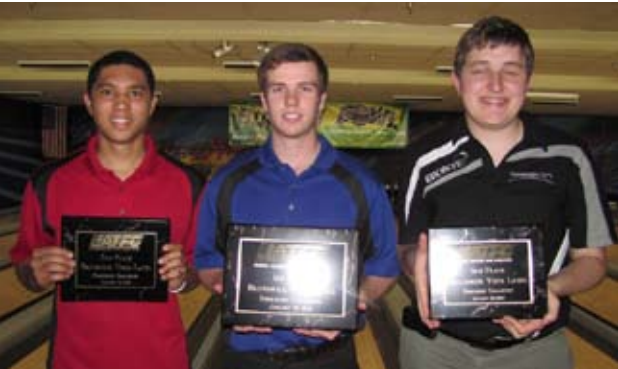
