Only 4 Weeks Until Tri-Senates \$15K Tournament at Cal Bowl

LAKEWOOD — There are only four short weeks before the big Tri-Senates of Southern California's Championship Tournament. In fact Saturday, March 15th is the deadline for the regular entry fee of \$65/ bowler. Entries received after that date will have a late fee of \$5 per bowler making it \$350 per team.

The single weekend tournament will be held on Saturday and Sunday, April 12th and 13th at the 68 lane Cal Bowl in Lakewood. This will be the third annual Tri-Senates of So CA Championship Tournament. The tournament will have a total of five squads to choose from, three on Saturday and two on Sunday.

The estimated pay out is a whopping \$15,000 to the first place team based on a minimum of 165 paid entries. Last years tournament brought in 171 entries and also paid out \$15,000 to the first place team as well as 22 total places for the tournament plus bonus pay outs to the top low average team (900 or under) and all seniors teams. With that being said, this is now one of the most popular tournaments in Southern California. In fact, it is anticipated that most of the squads this year will be completely full before the March 31st deadline. Therefore, bowlers are strongly encourage to get their team's entry in early to ensure they get the squad(s) of their choice.

In addition to the grand prizes, there are added incentives to attract "the average bowler" (teams with a combined entering average of 900 or less) as well as "seniors" (teams with all bowlers aged 55 and over). The tournament will be paying bonus prizes to the top teams in each of those two categories!

Each squad will also have an optional round robin sweepstakes doubles event as well as lots of side pots, brackets and the exciting "Team Eliminator" to start off each squad.

Nothing but pure fun and lots of prizes and side monies to be earned! With this tournament the Tri-Senates of So CA is reaching out to all bowlers from everywhere to participate. This is a handicap tournament with five bowlers per team, mixed with any kind of 3/2 combination. Multiple entries are allowed as long as three bowlers are changed.

There is also a 1050 maximum team entering average.

The tournament entry fee as previously mentioned is only \$65 per bowler or \$325 per team until this Saturday March 15th so please act now to avoid the \$70 per bowler entry fee for late entries. Also, we have incorporated a squad organizers bonus reward program. The Tri-Senate of Southern California was founded in 2006 and is an official affiliate of the National Bowling Association, Inc. (the second largest membership bowling association in the country next to USBC) and as such all participants must be current members of both TNBA and USBC. Bowlers without a current TNBA membership may purchase membership prior to the tournament by contacting their local bowling senate or one of the tournament directors listed in this weeks ad. UAE's Shaker Al Hassan Wins Kingdom of Bahrain International Open

John Szczerbinski comes up two pins short in bid for first PBA Tour title

MANAMA, Bahrain (March 7, 2014) – Top qualifier Shaker Al Hassan of the United Arab Emirates defeated John Szczerbinski of N. Tonawanda, N.Y., 231-229, Friday to win the \$25,000 first prize in the 12th Kingdom of Bahrain International Open at Ozone Entertainment Center, denying Szczerbinski his first PBA Tour title.

Szczerbinski, after eliminating fellow American PBA member Chris Loschetter of Avon, Ohio, 197-166, in the semifinal match, needed to beat Al Hassan twice in order to win the title, but came up two pins short in the first game. The win was Al Hassan's first in WTBA World Bowling Tour competition, but he does not receive credit for a PBA International Tour title because he isn't a PBA member.


The third event in a four-tournament WTBA-PBA International Tour series, the 11th Kuwait International Open, begins Monday and concludes on Friday, March 14, at Cozmo Bowling Center in Salmiya City, Kuwait. The four-event series concludes with the 10th Brunswick Euro Challenge from Dream Bowl Palace in Munich, Germany, March 15-23. USBC to change adult high score awards in 2014-2015



ARLINGTON — Starting August 1, 2014, the high score awards given to United States Bowling Congress adult members for a 300 game, 800 series or 900 series will become once-in-a-lifetime awards. This change comes as part of USBC's strategy to focus resources on national governing body services.

As part of the change to the high score awards program, any USBC member who received an award in one of the high score achievement categories as an adult prior to August 1, 2014, will not receive an award for that achievement again.

"With this change, USBC takes another meaningful step toward our vision of redefining the organization," USBC president Andrew Cain said. "I want to clearly emphasize that cost savings was only a small factor in the board's decision-making process approving the change. This is primarily about a philosophical shift to make USBC membership about supporting and protecting the sport.

"The board believes this adjustment to the high score awards program provides a good balance of preserving an organizational tradition while moving toward USBC's vision for the future."

The 11-in-a-row award also will be eliminated as part of the changes. All 300 games and 800 series at the USBC Open and Women's Championships will continue to be recognized and are not considered part of the once-in-a-lifetime policy.

"Given that more than 50,000 certified perfect games are rolled in a typical season, the board agrees it is unnecessary for the national governing body to provide awards for near perfection with the 11-in-a-row," Cain said. "We also believe special recognition is appropriate at USBC Championships, since these prestigious events are conducted in special venues on uniquely challenging conditions."

Associations still will be required to submit 300 game, 800 series or 900 series achievements so the bowler's record can be updated with each accomplishment. The 11-in-a-row achievement will not be recognized at the national level effective August 1, 2014.


Members who already have received once-in-a-lifetime recognition for a high score will have the ability to purchase additional awards for subsequent high score achievements. Sport Bowling awards will remain unchanged for the 2014-2015 season, with the exception of the elimination of the 11-in-a-row award.


