CRAIG KISRO WINS REGULAR DIVISION, WCST EBONITE SINGLES AT MISSION HILLS. PAUL APPLING, SUPER SENIOR DIVISION WINNER

LAS VEGAS—A very big challenge this past week-end as the usually high scoring tournaments of the WCST, were just the opposite. Last month at the Orleans Casino in Las Vegas, NV, a field of only 25 bowlers all were in the plus in the qualifying, as 9 bowlers averaged 240 plus per game, and the rest of the qualifiers averaged 225 per game. This tournament at Mission Hills, last week-end, had 43 entries, and only 5 were in the plus. Four in the Regular Division, and one in the Super Seniors. Craig Kisro (Granada Hills), who holds the WCST record for finishing 2nd in our finals, finally won a tournament. Craig, used a Urethane Hammer Bowling Ball. Craig, qualified 3rd, with 2073, for the 10 games, took the lead after game #1, and won all 8 of his matches Eddie Katz, finished 2nd in the Finals. Eddie's 1st 5 games in the finals: 141-233-143-234-300. This was quite a week-end for these type of scores. Making good

shots, and picking spares was the secret of getting to the finals. TOP 3: 1st, Craig Kisro, \$625.00, 2nd, Eddie Katz (Lakewood), \$425.00, and 3rd, Tim Tripp (Santa Clarita), \$340.00. Craig, winner by 182 pins. 21 Entries in the Regular Division, and 22 Bowlers entered the Super Seniors paid out 8 checks in each division for a \$5,520.00 paid out. Applications are being accepted for the Bowling Writers' Association of America's Chuck Pezzano Scholarship awarded annually to worthy recipients who are high school seniors, vocational school seniors or current college students. The award is named in honor of BWAA, United States Bowling Congress and Professional Bowlers Association Hall of Fame journalist Chuck Pezzano of Clifton, N.J.

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Maintain a minimum 2.5/4.0 GPA or equivalent
- Involvement in the field of communications
- Perform community service
- Participate in the sport of bowling
- Include at least one reference letter
- Write a short essay (350 words)
- Provide school transcript

First-, second- and third-place scholarships may be awarded based on applicants' credentials. Any or all of the funds may or may not be distributed at the discretion of the committee. Individual awards may not exceed \$1,500 per year and yearly combined scholarships may not exceed \$3,000 per year. If there are any ties, money will be split. Winners also will receive a one-year paid membership in BWAA.

To apply, log on to the BWAA web site at BowlingWriters.com, click on Scholarships and download the application. Complete the form and return it, including supporting documents, postmarked no later than June 1, 2011. Name and address of the chair will be included on the application.

Winners will be announced at the BWAA Annual Meeting & Convention at Bowl Expo in June in Grapevine, Texas, and they will be notified by the BWAA President.

ABTA Returns to Mission Hills This Weekend

WEST COVINA—We returned to West Covina Lanes this past weekend for our 4 day Memorial Tournament with a GREAT turnout of 707 entries. Again, we thank all the members of the ABTA for their support each week. We had a tough shot for the tournament each qualifying daily. Our cut score on Thursday was +47 for the men and +56 for the women. On Friday we had cut scores of +48 for the men and +7 for the women. On Saturday it was +45 for the men and +34 for the women. On Sunday it was +40 for the men and +67 for the women. Re-Entry squad on Sunday was +49 for the men and -10 for the women. The Super Seniors added to the board (4 men and 2 women) were Chat Dino (+13), Pattie Brode (+10), Lonzell Burnett (+47), Don Eide (+47), Romy Cajucum (+46), and Carl Nixon (+46). Super Seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 141 bowlers making it to the semi-finals this week. I might add that the lanes were done so well and fair as the cut scores were nearly identical daily. The top Qualifiers for this event for the Men was Andrew Navarro with a +193 and for the women a +96. Each of them will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Each week the top seed draws the Match Series, and this time it was worth \$2,130. The top seed drew a 392. We had one bowler that bowled this score during qualifying and it was pretty Marina Suos, she got a tidy \$2,130 and was quite happy to say the least. She is very deserving! At our next event we will estimate the Match Series at \$350. For the 3-6-9 Roll off, Fred Go was the last one to go for the \$1,400 pot, but missed on his second shot and received \$100 for consolation. The 3-6-9 will be \$1,500 at Mission Hills.

In our optional doubles, finishing in first were Sean Nguon and Giang Huynh with a 1435 for \$220. Finishing second was Jhun Tan and Don Quitangon with 1428 for \$200. There was a total of \$3,320 paid out in doubles and 39 paid spots with low to cash of 1319.

Due to the Fine Turnout, we would see 141 bowlers advance to Cash Checks. In the Semi's we saw James Samson lead the field with a +162 to sit out and bowl for the title this week. Runnerup was Arnold Trias with a +148 to sit out

the first round. It took a +49 for the men and +19 for the women to make our top 32 this week.

Our top seed Samson had the honor of drawing the Match Game worth \$3,500. The pot is maxed out and we have a back-up pot maxed out at \$3,500 and a 2nd back up pot started. He drew a 119. After a review of all the scores bowled, we had two bowlers who shot that score, they were Adam Drozd and Emily Yeung. They will each get \$1,750 for that 119 score. They will be happy and surprised as they were not there for the drawing. We will have \$3,500 next week at Mission Hills, and continue to build on the back-up pot, which is \$1,955. This week we had eleven new bowlers join us. Let us welcome these new bowlers to the club, Valhair Miller, Chat Dino, Quinn Miller, Maria Perotti, Jun Reyes, Ray Reynaldo Jr, Scott Halterman, Marilyn Balatbat, Christian Dupaya, Victor Aquino, and Nickolas Dougherty.

This would bring us to our top 32 Match Play finals. In the first round, the 15 losers were Catherine Cheung, William Zarek, Gino Mansilungan, Jeff Taino, Wendy Soo Hoo, Pablo Castro, Jean Colian, Carlos Umana, Kristin Willey, Tao Yang, Don Quitangon, Joshua Navarro, Ik Hee Youn, Korng Ngow, and Ben Bogaosian. They will each get checks for \$220. In the second round, the eight losers were Nickolas Dougherty, Michael Villarreal, Bella Ordonea, Godfrey Galsim, Eugene Haynes, Robert Ricketts, Reny Alkonga, and Ping Romero. They received checks of \$240 each. In the third round, the losers were Faye Josafat, Andrew Navarro, Marife Catalasan, and Arnold Trias. They received checks of \$325 each. This would get us down to the final five bowlers. At this point, our horses would be paying anywhere from a low of \$70 (Danny Guevarra) to a high of \$193 (Danny Eguilos) depending on who would win. In this round we saw Danny Guevarra (10th seed) bowling Henry Hoang (7th seed). In this match Danny continued his hot bowling in the match play and finish with a 274 to 223 to advance. In the other match we saw Danny Eguilos (15th seed) bowling Joenito Soon (6th seed). In this match, it would be the other Danny continue his hot bowling in match play to finish with a 231 to 188 for him to advance. Joenito and Henry finished in 4th and 5th getting checks for \$600 each. They

Bowled very well!

Our semi-final match was set and bowled on Lanes 13 and 14 with our 15th seed against our 10th seed. In the weekly "horses" we would see Danny Guevarra paying \$70 and Danny Eguilos paying \$193 if they would win their match. 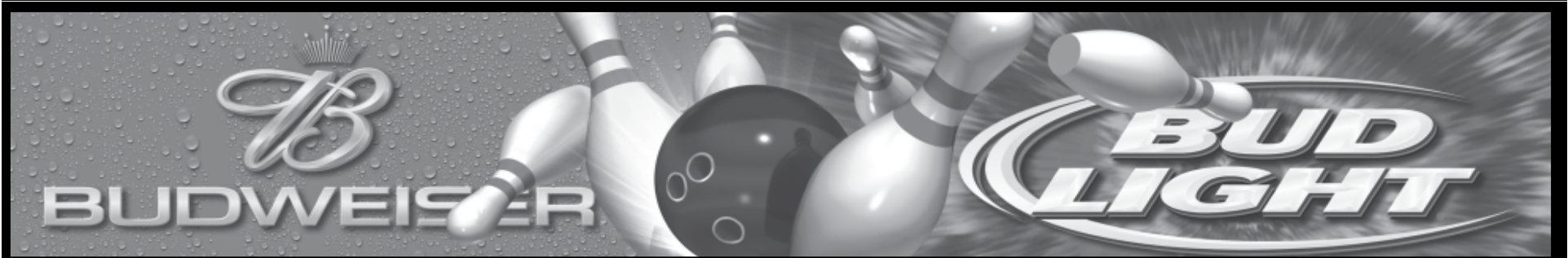
