GARDEN GROVE—25 Teams took to the lanes at AMF-Valley View, Garden Grove, CA, last week-end. Again this time, the scores unusually low for a WCST Tournament, but a lot higher than the Mission Hills Tournament, last Memorial day week-end. +142, made the 8 teams finals field for Sunday. Coming away with a big run away victory, was the team of 1st Time WCST Champions, Don Moser and Robert Piroozshad. Their team qualified 3rd on Saturday, 69 pins from the lead of +258, by the team of Marc Levy and Vince Wood. After Game #4, with one of the only two 500 team games bowled in the finals, which were both 511, started to really pull away from the field, and eventually won the tournament by 361 pins. Places 2nd to 4th, only 60 pins apart.. Don's team won 6 of the 8 team matches, and 12 of the 16 individual matches, all of these contributing bonus pins to the scores. The team of my ex-partner of this organization, and the big winner of the Senior High Roller, last month, D.A. Wright, and his partner in the doubles, a really nice bowler, Deeron Booker finished in 5th, but made a great showing in the tournament. The team of Gary Markowitz and Tim Tripp, who have won a championship in one of doubles tournaments, made a strong finish, to end up in 2nd place. Tim rolling the highest 8 game individual score of 1863. 16 checks paid out for a total of \$6,720.00, and for 8 tournaments this year, \$49,995 paid out, and for 329 tournaments, \$3,551,055.00 paid out.

Clemente Guajardo 1st ABTA Win at Mission Hills Bowl

Match Game again is \$3,500 Match Series estimate of \$900
ABTA Returns to Bowlm Lanes • 3-6-9 is \$1,600 at Bowlm Lanes

MISSION HILLS — Welcome to this week's edition of ABTA weekly. We returned to Mission Hills Bowl this past weekend with a decent turnout of 163 entries in our one-day event following the Memorial week. We had a decent shot for the tournament making the cut scores of +45 for the men and -10 for the women. The Super Seniors added to the board (3 men and 1 female) were Adam Drodz (42), Bob Minor (25), and Frances Brandt (-75). Super Seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 41 bowlers making it to the semi-finals this week. Our top qualifier for the Men was John Licauco with a +130. For the women it was Deborah Sanders with a +81. Each will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event.

Each week our top seed overall draws the Match Series, and this time it was worth \$286. Licauco (seed) drew a 411. We had no bowlers that bowled this score during qualifying. At our next event we will estimate the Match Series at \$900. For the 3-6-9 qualifying, Val Wise, Jeremy Paulsen, and Mariya Toro all missed on their final shots so they split

the \$50 consolation. The 3/6/9 will be \$1,600 at Bowlm Lanes.

In our optional doubles, finishing in first were Mike Moore and Freddie Manansala with a 1417 for \$110. Finishing second was Marvin Crowder and Leo Tartamella with 1396 for \$90. There was a total of \$730 paid out in doubles and 15 paid spots with low to cash of 1342.

In the semis we saw Jeremy Paulsen jump out to the lead after the first game, loose it during the second game, but come on strong in the third game to finish with a +155 to sit out and bowl for the title this week. Coming in second was William Garrett who bowled in the same group as Jeremy during the semis with a +127 sit out the first round. It took a +64 for the men and +23 for the women.

Our top seed Paulsen had the honor of drawing the match game worth \$3,500. The pot is maxed out and we have a back-up pot started that will for sure put the Match Game at \$3,500 for both of our handicap special events over the next two weeks.

Our top seed drew a 241. After a review of all the scores, No One matched the 241. We

will have \$3,500 at Bowlm Lanes, and continue to build on the back-up pot, which is \$2,420. This week we had four new bowlers joined us. Let us welcome these new bowlers to the club, Aricka Harris, Zacarias Arceno, Leanne Jilek, and Brandon Dziengielewski.

This would bring us to our top 16 Match Play finals. In the first round, the seven losers were Aricka Harris, Keith Nahan, John Licauco, Chris Kelly, Deborah Sanders, Carlos Medina, and Richard Samson, they received checks of \$100 each. In the second round, the losers were Bryan Moore, Wai-Tung "Andy" Mak, Justin Ziegler, and our second seed William Garrett, they received checks of \$107.50 each. This would get us to down to the final four bowlers. At this point, our horses would be paying anywhere from a low of \$41 (Jiradej Harnpanakitpanich (BK)) to a high of \$220 (Tiffany Paulsen) depending on who would win. In this round we saw BK (3rd seed) bowling Tiffany Paulsen (15th seed). In this match, we would see one of the house favorites in Tiffany go down in a close match to BK with a 208 to 191. In the other match we saw Clemente Guajardo (5th seed) bowling

Mike Moore (7th seed). In this match, it was close all the way down to the 10th frame. It would be Clemente who would take this match with a 235 to 232 finish. Tiffany and Mike finished in 4th and 5th getting checks for \$115 each.

Our semi-final match was all set now. It would be bowled on Lanes 21 and 22 this week and pit our 15th seed against our 3rd seed. In the weekly "horses" we would see Clemente paying \$110 and BK paying \$41 if they would win their match. In a match that was close, we would see BK jump into the lead after an open by Clemente in the third frame. BK would keep this lead through the first 7 frames even with an open by BK in the 7th, but at that point he would only lead by 3 pins. BK came up in the ninth and left a 5 count wash out on his first ball, and only picked up 3 pins. When Clemente came up he marked and that would give him the lead. He would get a strike and spare in the 10th to close out the match with a 188/238 to 181/227 to advance him to his first title match. That would give Clemente the victory and for those lucky "investors" that had him as a horse, he paid \$110. BK finished 3rd and received \$200.

The title game was set and bowled on Lanes 19 and 20. We would see a house favorite Jeremy Paulsen and one individual who drove all the way from Banning this week. Jeremy being the top seed elected to lead off the match. Jeremy would start out with marks in the first three frames. But we would see Clemente open with a double. He was already being spotted to a 19 pin handicap advantage. Jeremy could not seem to find his hot bowling that he had during semi-finals and we would see Clemente continue his hot match play bowling. Clemente would finish with a 191/241 to 187/218 to take home his first title. Clemente would take home \$1,000 for 1st place, \$1,700 for Cash and Carry, giving him a total of \$2,700 for the win. Jeremy received \$500 for 2nd place.

Champion Clemente Guajardo is from Banning and used a Roto Grip drilled by Joe Rickers at Hemet Lanes. He is engaged to another fine bowler Mariya Toro, and would like to thank his fiancée and future father-in-law Andrew, along with the rest of the Toro family, ABTA and Staff.

Jeremy Paulsen (2nd Place) is from Canoga Park and used a Storm ball drilled by Rusty Bryant. He is married to an-

other one of our fine bowlers Tiffany. He would like to thank her for the support and encouragement along with Mission Hills Bowl, ABTA and Staff.

Jiradej Harnapanakitpanich (3rd Place) is from Buena Park and used a Columbia Full Swing drilled by Mike Wahl. He is single and would like to thank Mike Wahl, Jenny for all her support and her "taxi service", ABTA and staff.

The winner of a 900 Global Ball was Glenn "Bracket Man" Matsumoto he won the Shredder. Each time you bowl, you get a free ticket for this prize given away by our Sponsor, 900 Global. In our weekly raffle, the winners for an ABTA entry were Wilson Cheung, William Ele, Tim Crowder. Winning an entry for our Las Vegas event was Allan Calabio. The rest of the results are in the payoff column in this paper.

Our next event will be at Bowlm Lanes for the first of our multi event handicap specials. To receive two bonus pins you must bowl both Bowlm and Classic Lanes. If you only bowl at Classic, you will still earn 1 bonus pin.

This week at Bowlm it will be a regular event, in that all cashers earning over \$100 will lose pins. We will have top 16 match play. Squad times are 12 pm, 1 pm, 2:30 pm, 4 pm and final qualifying squad at 6 pm. Please be on time to avoid the long line. See our ad for address and directions, or check our website (www.abta1.com) to link to address for directions. Did you receive a schedule in the Mail? If you did not, please send us an email via contact page with your Name and Address so we can send you one and get your corrected address in the system.

On a very sad note we are sorry to hear of the passing of Ed Shipley who was one of the nicest men you will ever know. I remember his joining the ABTA as if it was yesterday. It was at San Bernardino's SAN HI Lanes. Our only tournament there as they closed the doors the next day. He was an older man but very competitive on the lanes. He will be missed by myself and all who knew him, and surely by Mary Andruzyk his ABTA Bowling Partner! He was a Gem! ing from above and working on that perfect game up there where it means so much more. God Bless You and Your Family! It's history folks as Clemente Guajardo enters the archives as our latest champion.

NATIONAL DEAF BOWLING NEWS

3 RECORDS BROKEN IN 70TH PACIFIC COAST DEAF TOURNEY AT SUNSET STATION

HENDERSON—Despite the low entry of only 22 teams in the 70th annual Pacific Coast Deaf Bowling Association Tournament at Strike Zone Lanes in Sunset Station Hotel and Casino last memorial Day weekend, there were three tournament records broken. With absence of top-flight deaf bowlers, the below 200 average bowlers had a field day on the lanes as new records were made in team, doubles and all-events. Only the singles event record survived by 13 pins.

The records are from year 2008 when the captains and delegates voted for cut from 5-men to 4-men teams and handicap as 100% of 220 average. Here are the stories of each event.

PCDBA PRES. SULTAN LED NEWCOMERS/LAS VEGAS TO TEAM TITLE WITH RECORD 2875

Two teams made the rare handicapped 2800 score zone since 100% handicap is used and first time there are two of them. PCDBA President Howard Sultan who returned to bowling after recovering from a double bypass heart surgery last November, rolled 633 to lead his team Newcomers/ Las Vegas to a new record 2875.

Newcomers/Las Vegas which had 3 bowlers bowling in this tournament for the first time, scored games of 787-834-705 for the day's high scratch 2326 plus 549 handicap for the new record and \$800 prize. The old record of 2841 was made in 2008, the year the 100% handicap started. Besides Sultan's 633, this writer regretted not being able to name the three newcomers and their scores because he lost the page 3 of team results when he fell after end of the awards. Sultan's team series was found in all-events results and the three newcomers' names were not on the all-events results.

The other 2800 was made by San Diego Supermen whose team scores of 704-707-766/2177 plus huge 639 handicap for 2816 placed them 2nd for \$400. John Buhay led the team with 247-194-246/687, Thomas Hauser had 411, Tim Brown, Jr. 532 and Capt. Stephen Sinatra (205) 547 in their 2177 scratch total.

Third place \$200 prize went to Angel West "A" of Fullerton, CA with 2761. Ron Hogue led the team with 216-201-254/ 671, Paul Sanchez 483, Philip Hawkins (220) 540, Capt. Jeff Stansell (236) 614. After first two games of 731-718, the team hit the event's high team game 859 for 2308 plus 453 handicap for its 2761.

Fourth place \$125 prize went to Revolutions Pro Shop of Phoenix's 2757 whose Derek Gredinger shot 257-213-237 for this event's high individual series 707. So. Calif. Deaf Bowlers B, Los Angeles took 5th place \$104 with 2726. Sixth and last place \$90 in the team money went to Riverside Silent Bowlers.

PAUL SANCHEZ SACKS \$200 SINGLES TITLE WITH 861

The singles event had 86 entries and three bowlers finished with 800 plus for first time with this 100% handicap. Paul Sanchez, Anaheim came 13 pins short of the listed singles record of 874 made in 2006 when handicap was 80% of 210. Sanchez with 159 average surprised himself, rolling 224-186-268/678 plus 183 handicap for 861. For his efforts Sanchez gets \$200 and the singles title plaque.

Stan Booth, Moreno Valley who was at his best, made the other 800 with 258-257-210 for 735 plus 99 handicap for 834, good for 2nd place \$140. Third place \$100 goes to Jose Sermen, Queen Creek, AZ who was superb with 236-234-279 for tournament high 749 plus 51 for 800 on the nose.

Kevin Fulton, Elk Grove, CA tied Sermen for the event's 279 high game with 279-215-198 but his 692 plus 72 handicap 764 placed him in 7th for \$75. The last place score in the money is 21st with 723 for \$35.

SAN DIEGO DUO BROWN, JR & BUHAY SET DOUBLES RECORD WITH 1563

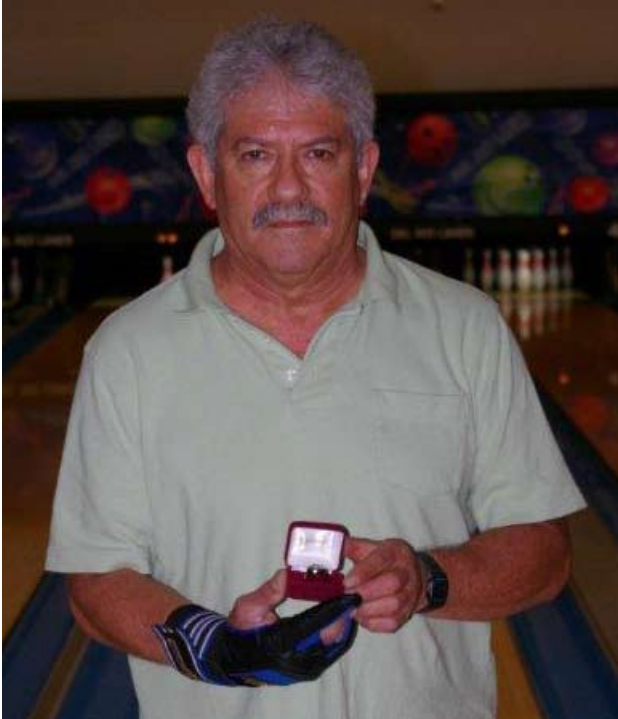

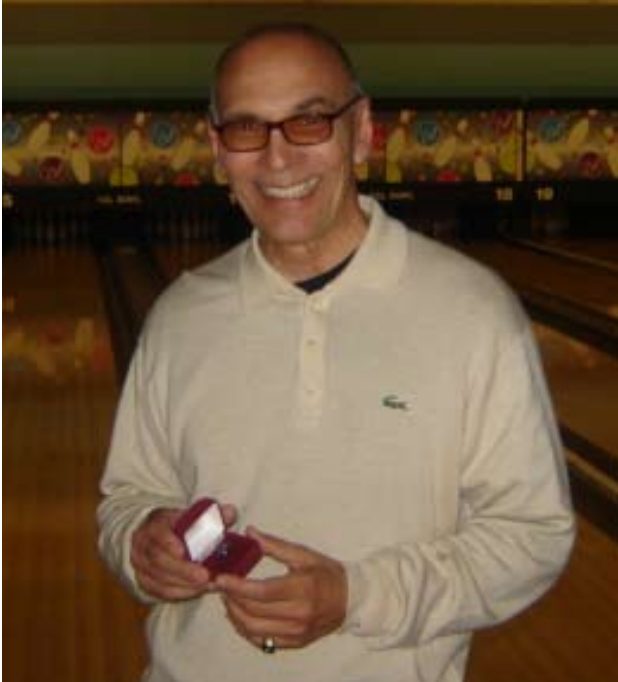
