Finland's Palermaa Wins Don Carter Division, **Advances to PBA World Championship Finals**

LAS VEGAS - Finland's Osku Palermaa took a big step forward in his quest to win his second Professional Bowlers Association title, advancing to the finals of the PBA World Championship by eliminating PBA Tour veteran Jack Jurek of Lackawanna, N.Y., and England's Stuart Williams and Dom Barrett in the Don Carter Division finals that aired Sunday on ESPN.

Palermaa, Europe's pre-mier two-handed bowling star, won the first of four PBA World Championship elimination rounds at South Point Hotel Exhibition Hall with a 223-188 victory over Barrett in the final game of the Carter finals. The divisional finals consist of three one-game rounds, starting with four players, and eliminating the lowest-scoring player after each game with the surviving player advancing to the PBA World Championship finals on Jan. 15.


In the opening game, Barrett led the group with a 257 game, Williams followed with a 215, Palermaa posted a 187 and Jurek was the first man eliminated with a 169. Backto-back unconverted splits in the second and third frames contributed to Jurek's early

Barrett again led the group in the second game with a 201, Palermaa was second with a 188 and Williams was eliminated with a 170 game. In game three, three splits which he was unable to convert doomed Barrett's bid to advance to the final round.

The Carter finals were conducted on the PBA's Viper lane condition, selected by Williams as the highest qualifier in the field of four.

Palermaa, who won his first PBA Tour title in the GEICO Shark Championship during the 2010 PBA World Series of Bowling, will join the winners of the Billy Hardwick, Johnny Petraglia and Mike Aulby Division finals in the PBA World Championship finals on Jan. 15 on ESPN. The PBA World Championship offers a \$50,000 first prize and the first major title of the 2011-12 PBA Tour season.

"It was difficult today," Palermaa said. "We didn't make the lane condition easy. The key was to try to bowl a clean game, because no one

was going to strike a lot."

Palermaa, one of 52 international players who represented 16 countries in the World Series of Bowling, said his international experience was a big help in Las Vegas.

"We bowl on everything in all different kinds of environments," Palermaa said of his world-wide experience. "We

have to be good on all kinds of conditions or we don't get a paycheck.

"I've been battling a flu-like virus for almost two months," he added. "I'm feeling better, but if I can bowl like this in the finals, maybe I'll want to be sick again.'





Kevin Valmonte hits 3-6-9 for \$2,300 • Match Game still at \$3,500 3-6-9 will be \$1,300 at West Covina, and Match Series estimated at \$650 ABTA Christmas Event at West Covina for 1 Day Event

ARCADIA—We returned to Bowling Square Lanes where we saw 155 entries come out and support the ABTA. We had a semi tough shot for the tournament making the cut scores of +81 for the men and +35 for the women. The Super Seniors added to the board (2 men and 1 female) were Art Windsor (+44), Sun Sundara (+43), and Sierrie Herradura (+29). Super Seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 42 bowlers making it to the semifinals this week.

Our top qualifier for the Men was Kurt Valmonte with a +170, and for the women it was Deborah Martin with a +88. They will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Our top seed overall draws the Match Series, and this time it was worth \$276. Kurt drew a 469. We had no bowlers that bowled this score during the qualifying squads. We will estimate the Match Series at \$650 at West Covina event. The last bowler for the 3-6-9 roll-off this week was Kevin Valmonte and he needed to get five 9 counts or strikes to take home the \$2,300. Kevin was able to pull off this feat and took home \$2,300. We will start the pot at \$1,300 this week at West Covina.

In our optional doubles, finishing in first were Kevin Valmonte (Again) YES! and Kurt Valmonte (Brothers) with a 1466 for \$130. Finishing second was Kin Sang Chung and Mark Andrews with 1447 for \$110. There was a total of \$1,190 paid out in doubles, 19 paid spots with low to cash of

After bowling 3 more games for the semi-finals, finishing in first was Nemesio Tagalag with a + 175. Finishing in second place to sit out the first round was Danny Gartin Jr with a +125 Our top seed in semi-finals had the honor of drawing the Match Game worth \$3,500, which is maxed out. Nemesio Tagalag drew a 237. After a review of all the scores bowled, we had one bowler who shot that score and it was Kent Maruyama who was contacted and gladly will accept the cash: :_). We will still have \$3,500 at West Covina, and continue to build on the back-up pot.

This would bring us to our top 16 Match Play finals. In the first round, the seven losers were Art Windsor, Deborah Martin, Julie Nguyen, Kurt Valmonte, Holden Au, Annaliza Agoncillo, and Scott Vasquez. They received checks of \$100 each.
