Vidad & Barefoot Win Back-To-Back Mixed Doubles Titles

BARSTOW — The Dynamic Duo of Paula Vidad and Frank Barefoot, paired up for only the second time as a team and won the 1st Annual WBA Barstow Mixed Doubles on Sunday. The pair won this past November in Mission Hills for their first title together. Both tournaments the duo led wire to wire.

The team led qualifying with +482 for 9 games, a 453.55 team average. Vidad of Sun City averaged 218.88 and Barefoot of Rancho Cucamonga with 234.66. The cut to make the Top 8 Match Play Finals was grabbed by Debbie Ayers and David "DJ" Carter

both hailing from San Diego with +223, a 424.77 team average. They edged out Lindsay Boomershine, Brigham City, UT and Rex Johnson, Las Vegas, NV by a mere 5 pins.

Sunday morning saw Barefoot come striking out of the gate and blasting 256-266-290 for an 812 series. The duo never looked back as they increased their lead and won by 317 pins over the runner-up team of Laura Lee Daniel of Corona and Chris Williams, Las Vegas, NV. Daniel also rolled the high game for the ladies with a 298.

THIS SUNDAY ON ESPN: USBC Masters Finals Live at Noon

NORH BRUNSWICK — The stepladder finals for the United States Bowling Congress Masters – the PBA Tour's second major of the 2014 season – will be telecast live on ESPN Sunday at Noon PT from Brunswick Zone Carolier in North Brunswick, N.J.

Reigning Masters champion and current PBA Player of the Year Jason Belmonte of Australia will be trying to make one of the stepladder finals spots by advancing through the demanding double-elimination match play rounds this week.

Belmonte, who won the Barbasol PBA Tournament of Champions in January for his second major title, won the 2013 Masters for his first major win, defeating 2013 U.S. Open champion Wes Malott, 258-245, in the title match.

Successfully defending the Masters title has proven to be a difficult task in the 63-year history of the tournament. It's only happened twice and not since 1965. Billy Welu won the event in 1964 and 1965, while Dick Hoover was the first to win consecutive titles in 1956 and 1957.

Following Sunday's live Masters telecast, PBA League quarterfinal action returns to ESPN on Sunday, March 2, at Noon PT when Chris Hardwick's Silver Lake Atom Splitters presented by Spiceworks (Chris Barnes, Dom Barrett, Tommy Jones, Wes Malott, Bryon Smith) takes on Terrell Owens' Dallas Strikers presented by the USBC (Norm Duke, Mike Machuga, Amleto Monacelli, Dave Wodka, Rhino Page) from Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park, Mich.

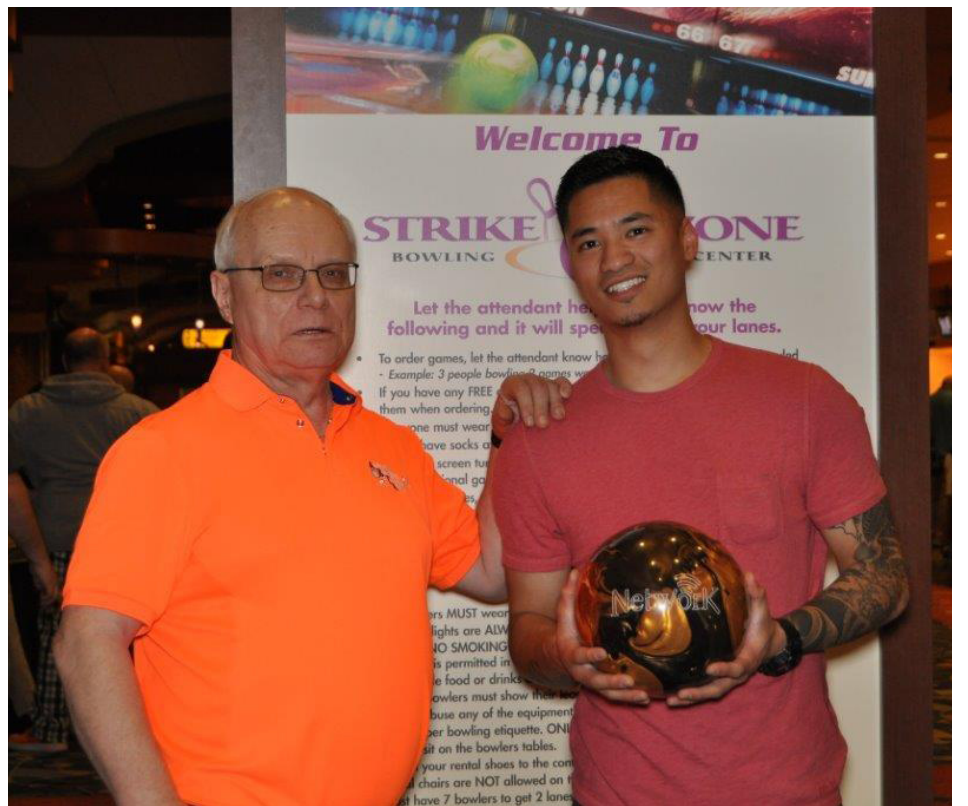

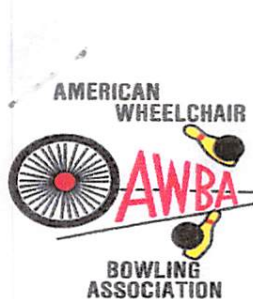
