NEW JERSEY, AKRON MAINTAIN WINNING WAYS IN MOTOWN

KingPins and Atom Splitters move into tie for second place

The final matches of Round 12 of the PBA Elite League, held at Strobl Arena inside Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park, Mich., took place on Sunday afternoon.

The KingPins prevailed over Lucky Strike L.A. X, while the Akron Atom Splitters defeated the hometown Motown Muscle in a pair of roll-offs.

Jason Belmonte, player-manager of L.A. X, secured the first game for his team with a strike and spare in the 10th

frame. L.A. X, which would have clinched a postseason berth with a victory, fell in Game 2,

216-179. In the roll-off, L.A.’s Dom Barrett matched New Jersey’s BJ Moore

opening strike. After New Jersey’s Marshall Kent struck and L.A.’s Darren Tang only knocked over eight pins, Packy Hanrahan clinched the match for the KingPins with a strike.

Motown and Akron clinched playoff berths in Round 11 earlier in the week, but playoff seeding was still on the line. With a win, Akron would move into a tie with New Jersey and the Portland Lumberjacks for second place and a bye.

VEGAS REBOUNDS, DALLAS KEEPS PLAYOFF HOPE ALIVE WITH ROLL-OFF VICTORIES

Anderson wins match for High Rollers in home city; Strikers stave off playoff elimination in roll-off

Round 12 of the PBA Elite League kicked off under the bright lights of Strobl Arena on Saturday afternoon.

The GoBowling Dallas Strikers defeated the Waco Wonders to increase their dwindling postseason hopes.

Both teams entered Round 12 with a 2-9 record, sitting last place and two games behind Lucky Strike L.A. X.

Despite Dallas’ record, the Strikers entered Round 12 boasting the third-best team average. Their opponents, however, average nearly 10 pins per game more



than any other opponent average.

“You can take averages and throw them out,” Dallas manager Norm Duke said before

the match. “This is about wins and losses. It’s do or die.”

On Saturday, the wins finally came for the Strikers. After losing Game 1,

220-180, Dallas rallied to win Game 2, 183-179, and the roll-off 27-23.

“We’re still in it!” Duke exclaimed as he walked continued on page 4

off the lanes. The second match featured the top two teams in the PBA Elite League: Las Vegas and Portland.

Las Vegas won the opening game, 198-177, on the left lane, but found tough sledding on the right lane. Portland won Game 2, 237-150, to force a roll-off.

In the three-player, one-ball shootout roll-off, Kris Prather's six-count put Portland in an early hole. Las Vegas' anchor, Detroit native Andrew Anderson, stepped up with an opportunity to strike and clinch the match.

"I was just trying to enjoy it," Anderson said. "You don't get this very often, not in this sport. It's just so hard to make TV shows, hard to win matches in the PBA League and I get a chance to do it in Detroit."

"I'm gonna remember that one for a long time," Anderson said.

The High Rollers take possession of the top overall seed and hold a 1.5-game cushion for a top-two seed and a bye.

Portland falls to 8-4, a half-game ahead of the Akron Atom Splitters and New Jersey KingPins, who both compete their Round 12 match Sunday at noon Eastern on FS1. The KingPins face Lucky Strike L.A. X, who hold a 1.5-game lead over Dallas for the final postseason berth. Akron will face the Motown Muscle. Both teams clinched a playoff berth with their Round 11 wins on April 3.

the match featured the two highest scoring games of Round 12, with Akron winning 258-247. The hometown Muscle fought back to win Game 2, 234-211.

In the roll-off, Motown anchor Anthony Simonsen needed a strike to extend the three-player shootout into a sudden-death roll-off. However, the 4-pin had other plans.

With two rounds to go in the PBA Elite League regular season, the Las Vegas High Rollers hold sole possession of first place. Portland, Akron and New Jersey sit in a three-way tie for second place. Portland owns the tiebreaker with their 3-1 record against the Atom Splitters and KingPins. Akron (2-2) sits in third over the KingPins (1-3). Motown, with a playoff berth clinched, sits fifth.

L.A. X holds a one-game advantage over the GoBowling Dallas Strikers for the final postseason berth through Round 12. L.A. defeated Dallas in both regular season matches; therefore, Dallas would have to win out with L.A. losing out to usurp L.A. and make the playoffs. The defending champion Waco Wonders sit in eighth place at 2-10.

The final rounds of the PBA Elite League regular season will be held at AMF Riviera Lanes later this month. Six matches will take place on April 22 at 6 p.m. Eastern on BowITV. The final two Round 14 matches — L.A. X vs. Portland and Akron vs. Las Vegas — will take place April 27 at 4 p.m. ET on FS1.



US Foods Jumps Out To The Early Round Lead

DOWNEY – The Brunswick Invitational took to the lanes for the first week of the wildcard round. Round winners will bowl each other for 8 weeks to determine overall seeding while the rest of the league will bowl six weeks to determine a wild-card round winner, followed by two weeks to determine the overall league wildcard. These two teams will be seeded 5th and 6th and will bowl each other in the first round of the rollofs.

In the battle for the round, the “A” match featured **Forever Hope Foundation** (Eric Williams Jr.) taking on **US Foods** (Gabriel Martinez). US Foods took the first two easy and the third by two marks for the 5-0 sweep to start the round. Gabriel Martinez (727) and Charlie Kinstler (700) put up a pair of sevens for US Foods while Frank Ortega’s 688 was high for Forever Hope Foundation. US Foods will remain in the “A” match next week as the round leaders.
