CALIFORNIA USBC HALL OF FAME

The California State USBC is looking forward to inducting four more Bowlers into their Hall of Fame.

Tish Johnson is well known for her bowling ability both on the State level and the National professional level. She has over 25 professional titles to her credit and she has won the California State Queens four times. She owns seventy two 300 games and has twenty two 800 series. She definitely deserves to be in the CAUSBC Hall of Fame for Superior Performance.

Paula Vidad has firsts in the CWBA State Scratch All Event Women's Scratch Team events, Women's Doubles event and the Citrus Belt WBA Queens. She also holds three titles in the WWPB Regionals; Mardi Gras Lanes, Westbrook Lanes and the National Bowling Stadium in Reno NV. She also holds the USBC Women's record for most 300 games in a singles tournament (three in twenty eight games- WWPB Palo Alto Ca.) Paula will be a wonderful addition to the Hall of Fame under Superior Performance.

Barbara Metzinger has been involved in bowling for most of her life and has been an asset to the Sacramento WBA, the California Bowling Writers and the California WBA. She's a master of promoting bowling from any angle adding to the success of anything she has chaired. Her tireless drive to GET THE JOB DONE makes her a perfect recipient of the Hall of Fame for Meritorious Service.

Vern Reilly will unfortunately not be in attendance to receive his award, but his spirit lives on in our hearts. He was a quiet, always smiling person who rarely got upset when things or people could have upset him. He was always being sought after by bowlers, bowling proprietors and managers for his knowledge. His work ethic did not go unnoticed. Vern was elected Director of the California State BA in 1976. He was appointed Secretary & Tournament Director for the state in October of 1983. In 1991 when Vern retired, he didn't, instead, he continued to work at the State office during the heavy lead times, and also worked the desk at Alpine Lanes. Vern served as a member of the Transition Committee helping to merge the Sacramento BA, WBA, and YABA. Vern's dedication to the Greater Sacramento area and the State BA certainly earn him the honor of induction posthumously into the Hall of Fame for Meritorious Service.

Mark Dyer Wins Regular Division For The WCST Ebonite Singles at Harley's Camarillo Bowl Dick Baker Super Senior Division Champion

CAMARILLO—Mark Baker (Moreno Valley), led the qualifying on Saturday, with 2402 for the 10 games, and then in the finals, won the tournament by 205 pins to the nearest finalists. This was Mark's 3rd WCST Title. Mark bowled 1495 and 5 of his 6 matches. Jim Harvey in the position round, rolled a 300 game, and ended up in a tie with Chris Thompson for 2nd place. Mark's victory earned him \$565.00 with Jim & Chris splitting 2nd & 3rd place prizes for \$355.00 each. First Time bowlers entered, now at the regular divisions age eligibility change, now at 40 & up, Kevin McBride, ended up 4th, and Gary Duran, in 6th place. This division is now in a transition change, and the hopes of the WCST is to rebuild it. 15 bowlers entered for a total pay-off of 6 places for \$1,965.00, and for the year so far, 6 tournaments,

has paid out \$49,645.00, and for 304 tournaments, a pay-off of \$3,525,726.00.

Woessner Crushes All-Events Record at Women's Championships

ARLINGTON — Jodi Woessner of Oregon, Ohio, charged into the record books Friday at the 2010 United States Bowling Congress Women's Championships, crushing the all-time record for all-events and tying the record for three-game series.

Woessner had a scratch all-events total of 2,330, an average of 258.8 for nine games, at the El Paso Convention and Performing Arts Center to beat the previous record of 2,231 set by Leanne Hulsenburg in 2005.

After shooting 764 in team Thursday night, Woessner returned Friday afternoon and fired 816 in doubles and 750 in singles. Woessner's doubles set tied the three-game series record set last year when Michelle Feldman shot 816 to win singles.

"I didn't know what any of the records were or what was leading, so I just focused on making good shots," said Woessner, who won the 2008 PBA Women's Series Shark Championship. "This is typi-

cally the week where most of the big scores are shot, and I'm one who thinks that if I can do it, anyone can do it. I certainly hope it holds up. This is a real thrill."

In the doubles set, Woessner had games of 259, 268 and 289, just missing an opportunity for a perfect game. She started Game 3 with nine consecutive strikes and needed just a mark with good count to lock up the 800 series.

After a perfect 10th shot for a strike, Woessner stepped up and the ball sailed to the left side of the head pin, leaving the 6 pin, to end her bid for a perfect game.

"I don't care how many 800s or 300s you shoot, if you don't get nervous in that situation you are a robot," said Woessner, who combined with doubles partner Tracey Distel of Lansing, Mich., for a 1,312 total. "When I threw the first one in the 10th and got the strike, it took a lot of the pressure off. But I just got up there and rushed to the line and threw a horrible shot."

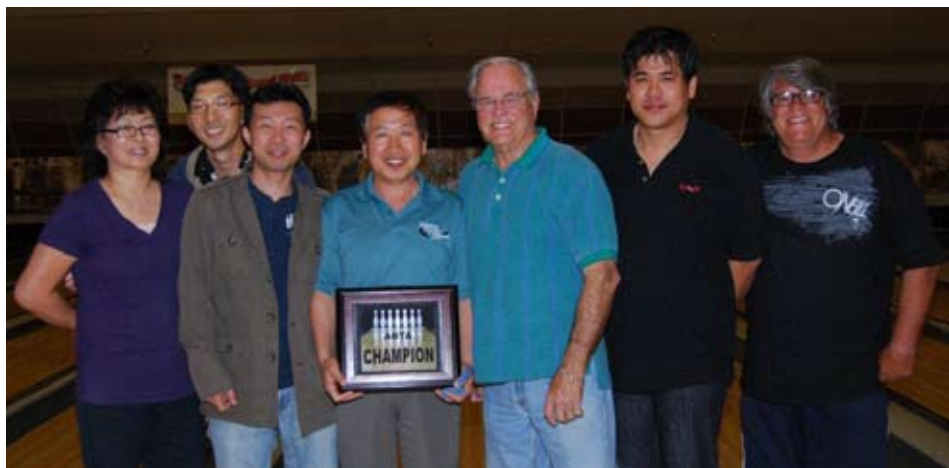
