Don Snyder was president; 600 attended.

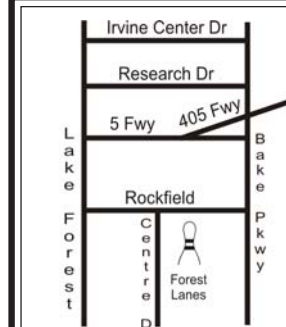

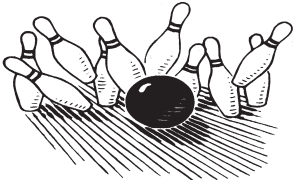

Riverside Wins Team Sweeper, Jim Mohr  
Singles & Doubles with Gardy Rodgers

MORENO VALLEY—So. Calif. Deaf Traveling League team champion Riverside continued its winning ways by capturing the season-ending team sweeper at Brunswick Moreno Valley Bowl. The six teams were closely contested until in the third game Riverside roared ahead with 638 with Emad Aranki's 190, Andy Lorenzo's 214 and Ed Abakumoff's 234. The Champs finished with a 527 for a 4 games total of 2183 to win by 52 pins for the \$120 prize.

Incidentally 2nd place prize of \$60 went to Los Angeles team which finished last in the regular season. Jim Mohr closed with a 228 to help his team to a 2131. South Bay got the 3rd place \$30 prize with help of Pablo Yoma's closing 225 for 2089 total.

Ed Abakumoff led the honor roll with 182-179-234-214/809 followed by Yoma's 173-204-202-225/804 and Bob Jones' 179-209-193-214/795. Gardy Rodgers had 199-205-214-168/786, Francisco Navarro 201-214-17+-175/766, Lorenzo 214/747, Darrell Stogryn 240/738, Mohr 228/732 and Don Millwee 705.

On the Sweeper's handicap side Jim Mohr scored 732 plus 160 hdcp for 892 to take the Singles prize by one pin over Gardy Rodgers' 786 plus 105 for 891. Pablo Yoma placed a distant 3rd with 804+76/880.

Then in the Doubles Mohr and Rodgers placed first for \$80, Mohr & Yoma 2nd \$60, Rodgers & Yoma 3rd \$40, Mohr & Navarro 4th \$30, Rodgers & Navarro 5th \$20, Mohr & Abakumoff 6th \$15, Rodgers & Abakumoff 7th \$10, Mohr & Lorenzo 8th \$7, Rodgers & Lorenzo 9th \$5 and 10th place Mohr & Jones \$3.

The league's Masters which was ran during the season, won by Darrell Stogryn who defeated Ed Abakumoff in January, its prize money was distributed to all.

The League prize money was given out and at \$4.17 per point first place Riverside got \$274.95 per bowler, largest ever due to increase in league fee to \$20.00. This does not count the above \$40 sweeper prize and the \$25 they had below special prizes. Hapless last place Los Angeles team who was hit with absenteeism and hard luck got \$160.10 per bowler.

Special prizes were distributed, cash in lieu of trophies, ss league champions, Riverside got \$45.00 and emblems from USBC and runner-up South Bay received \$30.

South Bay received \$30 for its 2396 team high series and Riverside got \$30 for its 673 team high game.

Darrell Stogryn had the season high series 955 and Ed Abakumoff the high game 275. Stogryn takes home the league's Charles R. Hart Memorial High Average Trophy for his leading 210 average.

This first and oldest all deaf traveling league will start its 48th year with a meeting in August. New deaf and hard of hearing bowlers are welcome. Must have 140 or better average. Email to Connie at dotcon@mfire.com or Ed at abakumoff@aol.com.

We will return next year at this center on the Memorial Day Holiday Weekend.

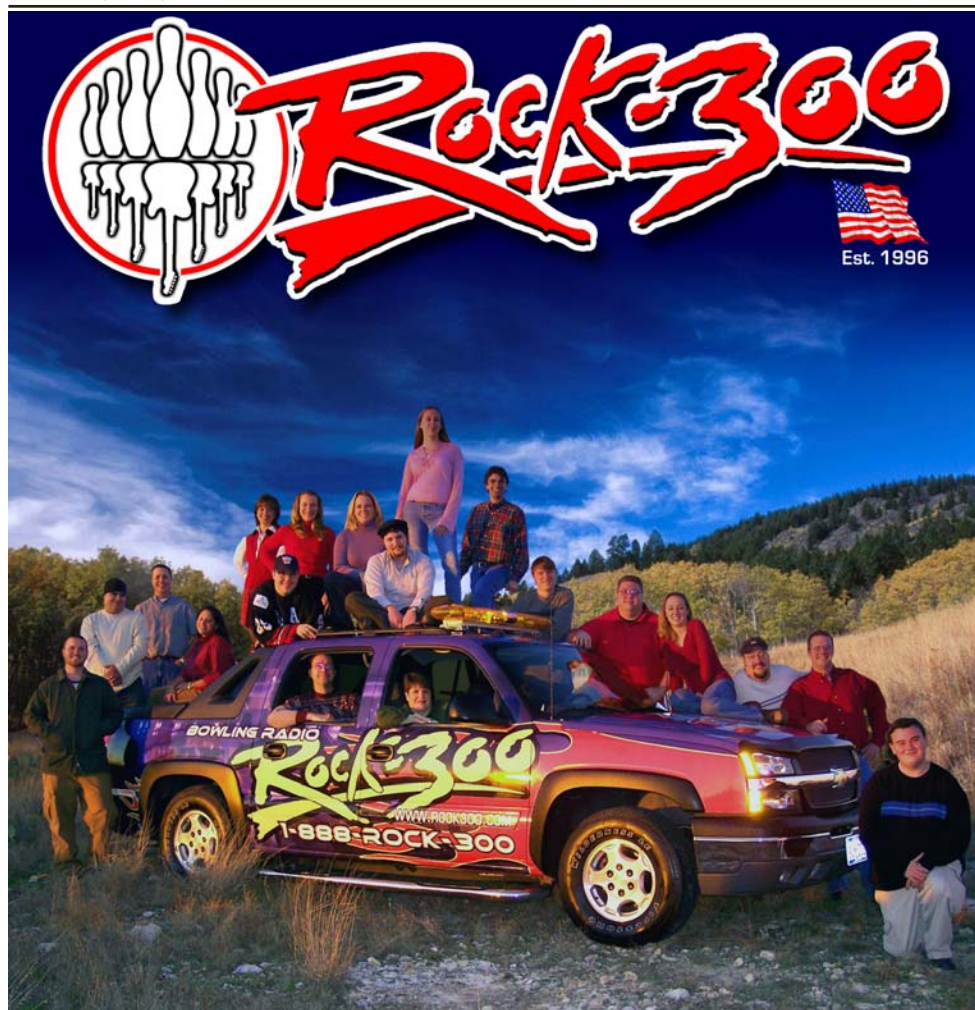
### \*\*SUPER SENIOR NEWS\*\*
