On the Sweeper's handicap side Jim Mohr scored 732 plus 160 hdcp for 892 to take the Singles prize by one pin over Gardy Rodgers' 786 plus 105 for 891. Pablo Yoma placed a distant 3rd with 804+76/880.

Then in the Doubles Mohr and Rodgers placed first for \$80, Mohr & Yoma 2nd \$60, Rodgers & Yoma 3rd \$40, Mohr & Navarro 4th \$30, Rodgers & Navarro 5th \$20, Mohr & Abakumoff 6th \$15, Rodgers & Abakumoff 7th \$10, Mohr & Lorenzo 8th \$7, Rodgers & Lorenzo 9th \$5 and 10th place Mohr & Jones \$3.

The league's Masters which was ran during the season, won by Darrell Strogryn who defeated Ed Abakumoff in January, its prize money was distributed to all.

The League prize money was given out and at \$4.17 per point first place Riverside got \$274.95 per bowler, largest ever due to increase in league fee to \$20.00. Darrell Stogryn had the season high series 955 and Ed Abakumoff the high game 275. Stogryn takes home the league's Charles R. Hart Memorial High Average Trophy for his leading 210 average.

We will return next year at this center on the Memorial Day Holiday Weekend.






