However, Danforth advance once more with a 233-202 win to meet top seed Page coming in at +332. Danforth started off strong with a string of strikes while Page just kept it close with a mix of



Lee Patterson Wins WCST Ebonite Singles At Keystone Lanes In Norwalk

NORWALK—Lee Patterson (Fresno), a brand new member of the WCST, entered the Keystone Lanes Tournament last week-end and won his first WCST Singles Title. This was not an easy task, as he had to over-come the lead of Kevin Gannon (Lakewood), the WCST All Time Money Leader and winner of 19 WCST Titles. Kevin, starting the finals had tied in the qualifying with John Parry (Oak Park), with a 2285 score for the ten games, started out the first game of the finals, the same way he did, when he won in Arcadia in May. In Arcadia, his first game of the finals was 299, and then he ran away from the field averaging 257 per game for the rest of the finals to win. This time a 280 first game, with only 7 more games to go for this finals as only 8 bowlers went to the finals in a small field. Lee at the end of Game #2, was down by 181 pins. Then Kevin started to have his problems, as he lost his next 3 matches bowling 596, as Lee was winning those matches with a big 739 score, and took the lead after game #5. Kevin rebounded with a 258 in Game #6, and won, but so did Lee with a 255 game and won. After Game #7, Lee had a commanding lead of 113 pins going into the position round, and beat Kevin 223 to 216, and the 30 pin bonus for the win, and eventually the title by 150 pins over Kevin. Lee had qualified 5th on Saturday, and won 7 of his 8 matches in the finals. Kevin won only 3 of 8.

This was not a high scoring tournament as 2174 by Super Senior, Jim Burke (Long Beach), made the cut. Jim also rolled a 300 game in the qualifying. Don Jackson (Bonita), was the other Super

Senior to make the Regular Division finals, and won seven and one half of his matches and finished 3rd, after starting in 7th place. Making the finals for the first time in the WCST was John Parry and Russ Simmons (Fontana). A tough week-end for entries as only 35 bowlers entered, with 10 of them being super seniors. As of the Wednesday before the tournament, we had 58 bowlers signed up, but due to other activities, and bowlers who had injuries, and those who had to work, and other various things that happen caused the many cancellations. The next 3 tournaments are looking very good for entries. \$4,420.00 was the total pay-off. For 6 tournaments in 2005, a total of \$39,045.00 paid out, and for 221 tournaments a total of \$2,413,888.00 has been paid out.

Top 3 places in the Finals: 1st, Lee Patterson, \$800.00, 2nd, Kevin Gannon, \$600.00 and 3rd to Don Jackson, \$400.00. All in all, 10 places paid out for the regular division.

SUPER SENIOR NEWS

With only 10 entries in the tournament, 3 super seniors for their finals had a step-ladder roll-off following the qualifying on Saturday. 2nd All Time Money Winner in the WCST, and winner of 16 WCST Titles, Vaughn Doody (Las Vegas), won his 17th by beating Fred Kouri (Apple Valley) 278 to 212.

Fred had won his first match from Bill Rybold (Visalia) 238 to 225. Money won: 1st, Vaughn Doody, \$500.00, 2nd, Fred Kouri, \$300.00, and 3rd, Bill Rybold, \$250.00

National Deaf Bowling News

*Great Lakes Deaf Bowling Ass'n Cahen Masters Results
Moran Hits 300 & Beat Davis In Championship Finals*

Note from this writer: The results I received showed only the prize list from 1st to 51 places, names of bowler, his hometown and amount of money won. Because of a 300 game was made by the winner, I had to chase to get more info to write this story. Thanks to the winner Kevin Moran who responded with the best of his memory because he did not have his score sheets..

MERRILLVILLE...Great Lakes Deaf Bowling Association ran its 23rd annual Herman Cahen Masters all day on Friday April 15 at Stardust Bowl II as the kick-off prior to its 69th annual tournament which was conducted on the following Saturday and Sunday. According to GLADBA Vice-President Roger Carroll, there were 136 entries and the host sponsor Camelot Deaf Club donated the first place prize of \$1,520.00 which went to the eventual winner Kevin Moran of Rochester, NY.

According to Moran, in the Masters qualifying round in the morning, Bill Davis, Chicago led with 773 score, followed by James Muehlbach, Milwaukee in 2nd and the two time defending Champion D. J. Powell, Indianapolis who won in 2003 and 2004 and was looking for a "threepeat" in 3rd. Moran, himself rolled his 300 in this round and placed 4th.

In the afternoon's one game step ladder match play finals, Moran faced Powell and denied Powell's chances for three straight by winning with 245 to Powell's 225 score. Next, Moran moved up a step against Muehlbach and defeated him by score of 217 to 180. Then in the Championship finals against rested Davis, The scores were close and Moran won \$1,520.00 prize with his 221 to Davis' 211.

As the runner-up, Davis received \$764.00, Muehlbach got \$390.00 for 3rd and Powell \$250.00 for 4th. The 5th place \$175.00 went to Ron Zuchegno, Rochester and the prize money ran down to with the 39th to 51st places receiving \$50.00 each. Former Champions Richard Egger, Toledo (2001) who later on Sunday established a new All events record with 2210, placed 16th for \$100.00.

Incidentally, Moran mentioned that he is the 2nd bowler to bowl a 300 and winning the Masters in the same year. In 2000, Cary Nagel, St Paul also rolled a 300 and later won the event. Nagel tried to be a two-time winner but placed 31st in this year's event for \$60.00.

Oddity, Moran admitted that his 300 came in 2nd games after a 258 in 1st game. This 300 is his career third and all came in deaf tournaments in the qualifying rounds. He could not understand why he failed to get a single 300 in his leagues.

Kevin Moran's name came in prominence when back in 1990 at New Orleans, he was a surprise unknown out of 141 entrants who, in his first National Deaf Masters battled his way up to the title finals against the deaf pro Frank Gallo, Jr. Gallo defeated him for his 4th National Deaf Masters title.

LEWIS BEATS LEIKER FOR GLDBA SENIOR CITIZEN MASTERS

GLDBA also held its 12th annual Senior Citizen Masters on the same day for its senior bowlers. I do not have all the information on qualifying and match play games except the prize list.

Harry Lewis, Flint defeated Harold Leiker of Olathe, KS a former (1992) National Deaf Masters Champion in the title finals for the \$400.00 prize. Leiker received \$200.00 for his runner-up finish. A former Cahen Masters Champion (1985) and 1997 Deaf Team USA member Anthony Kovacs, Detroit got \$125.00 for third and Ron Moore, Indianapolis placed 4th for \$100.00. This event's prize list ran down to 12 places.

Next year's GLDBA 70th annual Tournament will be in Chicago.

ABAKUMOFF HITS 1009 IN SUMMER SINGLES LEAGUE AT MORENO VALLEY

GARDEN GROVE—Christopher Lee hadn't had much luck in the ABTA until this Saturday when he stepped up and won four straight matches in the top 16 single elim finals finally downing top seed Super Senior Richard Aneso in the title game to take home the crown, and a tidy \$2,300 1st prize.

The turnout was nice this week as we had 194 entrants and saw 45 bowlers return to the Semifinals. The cut was Men +52, Ladies +24. 
