## Citrus Belt's JOSEPH DE LA TORRE On Talk Radio

SAN BERNARDINO—Mark your calendars for Friday, August 13th at 9:05 AM, PT and listen to Citrus Belt's own Joseph De La Torre on BILL ZUBEN'S nation wide radio bowling talk show. Joseph will be talking about his revolutionary new invention, the De La Torre Bowling Pin Retrieval System.

Joseph's invention is revolutionary because it allows the pin setter to retrieve pins in the channel or on the lane up to ten feet in front of the pin sweep or pin deck. Currently, the pin sweep can only pick up pins behind it. With this system there will no longer be a delay in bowling, to retrieve "dead wood." Just press a button at the score table and this new pin retrieval system retrieves any out of play pins.

De La Torre told me he got the idea for his invention about five years ago while league bowling. He had to wait five minutes for a lane man to retrieve a teammates "dead wood" while he was up next, and was trying to finish off a 300 game! Joseph said it was frustrating to sit by so long while under pressure, to finish off a perfect game. With his pin retrieval system there would have been no delay and much less anxiety.

## PBA Hall of Fame Del Ballard Jr. Successfully Battling Tonsil Cancer

TEXAS—Professional Bowlers Association Hall of Famer Del Ballard Jr. of Keller, Texas, is undergoing treatment for tonsil cancer with expectations of a full and complete recovery.

Ballard, a 12-time PBA Tour champion and winner of four major titles, is undergoing chemotherapy and radiation treatments at Texas Oncology, an affiliate of Baylor University. According to Ballard's wife, PBA Women's Series champion and USBC Hall of Famer Carolyn Dorin-Ballard, the rare form of cancer affected only the soft tissue at the back of his throat, but not his throat itself. "A big, big difference," she said.

The 47-year-old Ballard was diagnosed after returning from a trip to Saudi Arabia in May with a sore throat that wouldn't go away. When

## National Deaf Bowling News DEGROFF DETONATES HIS CAREER 28TH 300 AT JEWEL CITY BOWL

GLENDALE—A determined Ken DeGross emailed, it's about time he finally hit his 5th perfect of the season on Friday July 30 to keep close to the season's six 300s made by his two US deaf and hearing impaired friends. Previously Carl Malucci, Las Vegas and David J.(D.J.) Powell of Indianapolis had notched their 6th 300 the most ever by a deaf bowler in a season.

Ken's latest gem, which is his career 28th came in the third game of a 779 series (223-256-300) in Friday night Linda's Las Vegas League at Jewel City Bowl.

In his email, Ken said, he started with Storm's Reign of Fire ball and did okay getting a 3 bagger, 10 pin tap in the 4th and missed it, doubled in 5th and 6th and in 7th left a 4-9 split but spared that and left a 4 in on his fill ball for his 223.

In his 2nd game, after first two spares Ken switched balls

to new Storm's Prodigy and ran 5 strikes in a row from 3rd to 7th, left a 7 pin tap, spared in 8th, a turkey in 9th and 10th and again left a 4 pin on his fill ball for 256. In his third game Ken said, there were no mistakes and all 12 perfect shots.

There was a crowd enthralled by Ken's bowling style and pin blasting, clapping at the end.

Many of the fans and bowlers congratulated Ken and even told him that he is the man and the best ever world deaf bowler in USA. Ken laughed and accepted that as funny. Ken thanked them for the lots of support they gave him in this league.

The bowling season ends on August 31 as the new Fall season begins, Ken said he would try to get his 6th 300 soon and if not, try to get it before December 31. Also that he is not worried but glad he is close to that of his two friends.

## Hall of Famer Helen Duval Passes Away at Age 94

ARLINGTON—Helen Duval, a United States Bowling Congress Hall of Famer, passed away Thursday, July 29. She was 94.

"Helen was a very talented bowler and she touched so many people's lives through her work with the Bowlers to Veterans Link and her years of coaching youth bowlers in California," said USBC President Darlene Baker, who also chairs the BVL board. "She was a tremendous ambassador for the sport and will be greatly missed."

A lifetime resident of Berkeley, Calif., Duval started bowling in 1938 and joined her first league a year later. She had taken a job after graduating high school and after work each day she had to wait for the bus to go home. She passed the time watching people bowl at the nearby Cal-Rec Center.

"Somebody asked me if I'd like to try bowling," Duval recalled in a 2006 article for the Contra Costa Times. "I had never tried it before. I was a natural."

She would go on to become one of the pioneers of women's bowling, and was a founding member of the women's professional bowling movement in 1959. She won two professional titles during her career and in 1961 captured the Nationals Doubles tournament with Nobu Asami.

In 1969, Duval won both the Women's International Bowling Congress (now USBC) Championships team event and all-event titles. She was selected to the All-American Bowling team three times and held a high average of 200 in 1967.

Duval also proved to be a great teacher of the sport. She started teaching bowling clinics in the 1950s when the American Junior Bowling Congress requested she help bring the sport to California's youth. After impressing people in the states, Duval traveled to Asia where she conducted more bowling clinics and seminars.

She said in a 1992 Bowlers Journal article that her son, Richard, was her motivation. Richard was diagnosed with polio at age 5 and was hospi-

talized for almost a year. But Duval helped her son to bowl—he started in a wheelchair and later was able to stand at the foul line—and Richard eventually became accomplished enough to have a short stint on the Professional Bowlers Association Tour. The experience of working with her son helped her develop techniques for teaching disabled individuals.

She did extensive work with the BVL, the nonprofit group that provides programs to veteran and active duty service men and women. For more than 20 years she went to veterans hospitals across the country to teach the sport. The BVL named her honorary co-chair in 1985 and in 2000 she received the Secretary's Award, the highest award given by the Department of Veterans Affairs, for her unwavering commitment to America's veterans.

Duval was honored as a "bowling legend" at the National Bowling Hall of Fame and Museum's Salute to Champions Gala in 1993. Two years later she received the Bowling Proprietors' Association of America V.A. Wapensky award. She was selected as the BPAA's Dick Weber Bowling Ambassador Award winner in 2007.

Duval, who owned an eight-lane bowling center in Oakland, Calif., along with

her husband, Rosy, was one of the first women to become a member of the President's Council on Physical Fitness. She served for five years, following her appointment during the Kennedy administration.

She was inducted into WIBC (now USBC) Hall of Fame for Superior Performance in 1970, and was inducted into the Ladies Professional Bowlers Hall of Fame in 1995. In 1996 she was inducted into the Senior Athletes Hall of Fame.

A memorial service is scheduled for 1 p.m. Friday, Aug. 20, at the Chapel of the Chimes, 4499 Piedmont Avenue, Oakland, Calif. In lieu of flowers, a donation in Helen Duval's name can be sent to the Bowlers to Veterans Link, 11350 Random Hill Rd., Suite 800, Fairfax, VA 22030.

With one left hander cashing out of higher money in the regular division.

A total of 29 bowlers in the regular division, paid out 9 checks for a total of \$3,900.00, and in the Super Seniors, 21 bowlers entered for 7 checks paid out for a total of \$2,845.00. It was good to see the increase in the regular division's entries, as we have now lowered the age limit to 40, and expect the entries now to continue to increase. For 13 tournaments this year, \$96,850.00 paid out, and for 313 tournaments, a total amount paid out, \$3,570,886.00. Other 300 games in the qualifying: Gary Markowitz, and Lyle Rollins. Top 3: 1st Place, Bob Drake, \$800.00, 2nd Place, Steve Smith (San Diego), \$625.00, and 3rd to Gary Markowitz (Northridge), \$480.00.
