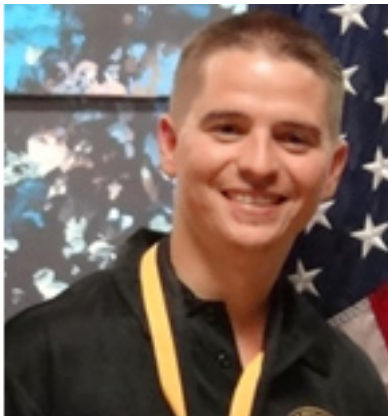

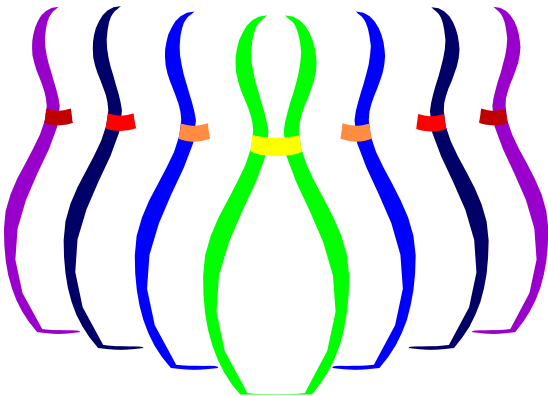
Some of the local associations like North LA County has their own awards that they have providing for years too. <http://nlacbowling.com/awards.html>

SAN DIMAS — We returned to Chaparral Lanes where we saw a decent shot throughout the day. 214 entries came out for a great day of bowling. The cut scores were +75 for the men and + 8 for the women. The Super seniors added to the board (two men and one Woman) Mamerto Jablan +68, Bonifacio Liscano and Lonzell Burnett +66. For the women it was Carla Sanchez +25. Super seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 49 bowlers making it to the semi-finals.

The High qualifiers for the tournament were Chris Kelly for the men with +161. For the women it was Yen Lach with a +80. They will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Each week one of our top seed draws the Match Series, and this time it was worth \$2,610. Yen would draw a score of 607 and Mark Fisser matched that score during the 4 pm squad and he gladly accepted the Reward!! Mark is Most Deserving. Congrats

Mark, and the Fisser family who are avid ABTA supporters. Freddy Catamisan was the last person left to go for the 3-6-9 pot and he missed, going for the \$2,500 Pot so he got a \$50 Consolation. We will go for \$2,600 at Westminster.

In our optional doubles, finishing in first were Marvin Crowder and Chris Kelly with a 1446 for \$120. Finishing in second place was Steve Brode and Chris Kelly with a 1444 for \$100. There was a total of \$1,120 paid out in doubles and 21 paid spots with low to cash of 1346.

We now are in the Beat the Board Finals. Where you finish is Your cashing position. ALL 59 Bowlers will cash. Going for the top prize of \$1,000, and with bonuses can be up to \$2,900. The bowlers took the floor and after the first game, the low for the top 13 men was +25 and the low for the top 3 women was +14. The top 5 bowlers were Mamerto Jablan with a +42, Tim Tran with a +44, Galdino Chavez with a +45, Emilo Flores with a +64 in second and in first was

Danny Eguilos with a +81. He took the first game side pot for \$65. After the second game, the low for the top 13 men was +43 and the low for the women was +32. The top 5 bowlers after the second game were Jesse Boquio and Kelly Wynn +74, Emilio Flores +99, Meng Chea +104, Danny Eguilos +107, and first was Mike J. Moore with a +111, he also took the 2nd game side pot with a 282 for \$65.

During and after the final game, we had more changes in the top spots. This week due to ties, we would have 18 spots being paid \$100 or more. Finishing in 10th thru 18th for \$100. were Mien Barcelona +31, John Gonzales +50, Marvin Crowder +50, James Chambers +50, Manuel Laygo +54, Jesse Boquio +58, Christopher Eguilos +60, Mark Fisser + 65, and Sandy Rosenblum +74.
