OROVILLE—The ENTRY CLOSING DATE for the 2008 California USBC Association Prince/Princess Tournament has been extended until October 6, 2008. You and your friends still have time to enter this singles tournament for 175 and under average bowlers.

Tyme to Bowl Lanes in Oroville is the host for the Annual California USBC Prince/Princess Tournament to be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, October 17 - 19, 2008.

The 2007 CUSBC Princess winner, Linda Dance from San Jose will be defending her title. The entry fee for the Prince/Princess Tournament is \$40.00 per bowler and the tournament is open to ALL California USBC members, who have a 175 and under average, and will have separate divisions for the Prince and Princess entrants. The tournament will consist of a six (6)

game Singles Event (2 three game blocks), changing lanes each block. The tournament is handicapped, using a basis of 90% of 200.

Squad times are still available on Friday at 2:30 p.m. and 7 pm, and on Saturday and Sunday at 9:30 am, 1 pm and 5:00 pm and 9:00 pm. This year's prize fund is estimated at approximately \$4,500, based on 300 entries.

## Gary Markowitz & Tim Tripp Win The WCST All Star Doubles at Buena Lanes

BUENA LANES—WOW! What a big weekend at Buena Lanes in Ventura, as 57 teams entered and the tournament, set the highest record scores in the history of the WCST. Gary Markowitz (Northridge), and his partner, Tim Tripp (Santa Clarita) came all the way from 11th in the qualifying of the 12 teams that bowled to win by 109 pin margin. Their Individual match wins of 17 of a possible 24, gave them the advantage along with 8 team wins. Tim rolled a 2930 score for the 12 games, while his partner added 2821.

For the 1st 6 games, The teams of Mark Dyer-Frank Barefoot Jr. & Ty Dawson -Dave Wodka, Exchanged 1st place every other game. Then Mark Dyer's team started to run away from the field, as Ty & Dave start losing ground, eventually ended up in 9th place. It looked like Mark & Frank would be the winners, but Gary & Tim closed in fast, and at the end of Game 11, trailed the leaders by only 26 pins, going into the position round.

The team of Joe Goldstein, and Paul Mandap, in 3rd at the time, won their match big. Gary & Tim beat Mark & Frank, 439 to 357, and with the bonus pins, ended up winning the tournament. Joe & Paul, ending up in 2nd place. TOP 3 Teams: 1st, Gary Markowitz-Tim Tripp, \$2100, 2nd, Joe Goldstein (Hayward)-Paul Mandap (S. San Francisco),

\$1700, 3rd, Mark Dyer (Moreno Valley)-Frank Barefoot Jr (Upland), \$1400.00. There were seven 300 games recorded, and seven 290 plus games, and numerous amount of 250 games or better.

This game again went to Ele who was putting on a show in a 191-171 win and Jason a faithful member was 3rd and \$200 with William on to meet Cash for the title.

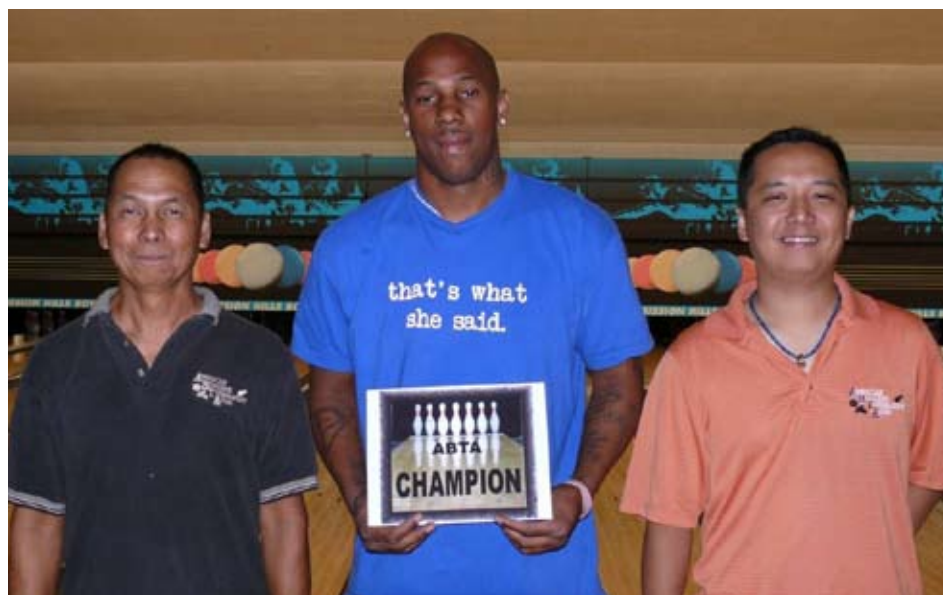
The title game now underway had Cash mark the first two frames. Ele was having a nightmare after bowling so well, with opens in the first five frames and then struck.
