PBA DEBUTS 2025 PBA ON FOX TOUR SCHEDULE

New-look PBA Elite League: Battle of the Brands and expanded PBA Playoffs elevate the 2025 PBA Tour

A Wandering Vagabond...

Whatever Happened To Rich Carrubba?

A few weeks ago we wrote an article entitled, "Kings Bowl - A Center Fit For A King," appearing in most publications in September of 2024. It was one of the establishments memorialized in a new book called simply, "Bowlarama: The Architecture of Mid-Century Bowling," by author Chris Nichols.

During the course of the article, we flashed back to 1977, when the USBC state tournament was being held at Kings Bowl and nearby Millbrae Bowl in the peninsula area just south of San Francisco. I had decided at the time to get together a group of my newfound friends from the PBA and form a team to compete in the annual event.

Here's an excerpt from that story: "Larry Laub

(my chauffeur) and Ron Lisher (my roommate on tour) were the first on my list and they both said yes. Next up came Rich Carrubba from Hayward, and Tim Harahan from Marina Del Rev. Carrubba was an instant yes, but I had to coax Tim into joining by naming the team after his (and Laub's) new bowling center, Hawthorne Bowl, located about 30

minutes south from his home on the 405."

One of my internet friends wrote and asked, happened "Whatever to Rich Carrubba?" I told him that I remembered reading on Larry Lichstein's blog that he had passed away, and that I would follow up to see what I could find. Here are my findings about Rich, one of bowling's many vagabonds...

Rich Carrubba did indeed pass away in 2021 at the age of 74. He first gained fame while bowling at Fiesta Lanes in Hayward, a bowling center where I was fortunate to have rolled my 2nd sanctioned 300 game while competing in the Professional Central California Bowlers tournament. It was also the first time that I cracked the prestigious top five

in a professional event. The year was 1974.

Fiesta had its share of top flight bowlers that would go on to fame in the bowling world. Perhaps the most notable was Jim Godman. who also died much too young at the age of 55, in 2001. Godman had a storied career, winning the USBC Masters in 1971, as well as the continued on page 3

Classic Doubles and All Events titles in 1974. But he will most be remembered for his Firestone Tournament of Champions titles, in 1969 and again in 1973. He was a fierce competitor.

About Rich Carrubba

Richard Dean Carrubba passed away on Tuesday, January 19, 2021. He lived in Diamondhead, Mississippi, with his loving wife Gayle. They married while living in Las Vegas, where Rich was the Resident Professional for Coast Resort's two bowling properties at Gold Coast Casino & Hotel, and the Orleans Casino & Hotel. He was there for 10 years.

Prior to that, Rich had attended the University of California at Berkeley for one year, but in 1966 he elected to join the United States Air Force. He served honorably in Vietnam and attained the rating of Staff Sergeant. Upon his return to the USA in 1969, he decided to start a career on the Professional Bowlers Tour.

During my time at American Recreation Centers, I remember Rich applying for a position as a bowling center manager in the Sacramento district. But I could sense that Rich was not going to be happy just managing a bowling center. It was not long after that he left the Coast Resorts Properties and landed a job with Storm Bowling in Utah, where he remained for ten years, achieving the title of Vice President of Business Development.

Following his foray with Storm Bowling, he ended his business career by writing on the internet for his good friend Keith Spear, owner of bowlingball.com. Many of Rich's YouTube videos from his years with Mr. Spear can still be viewed online. One of my favorites is a tribute to bowling great Don Johnson. When I was first sent by AMF to New College Park Bowl in Las Vegas, one of the first events that I conducted was a monthly scratch 10 game endurance on Sunday afternoons.

I invited Don, the house pro at Charleston Heights Bowl, to come and bowl with some of the other two dozen ex-PBA members in the Las Vegas All Stars league at Charleston Heights. To my surprise, Don showed up and tied Jack Shannon for the top prize. Rather than have a rolloff, Don and Jack decided to split the first and second place prizes. Johnson's attendance in that first 10 game endurance added credibility to the tournament, and it continued for many years.

Here now is that video from Rich Carrubba, focusing on just releasing the ball, rather than lifting the ball, one of Don Johnson's basic teaching methods:

You can see that Rich is very much at home with these instruction videos, and he's not reading from a script! His messages are truly from the heart, and even though most are from about 10 or more years ago, they are still apropos to the game of bowling... today!

FINAL THOUGHTS: One memory I will always have is Rich "sparing" with the 10 pin when it wouldn't fall. Rich was an intimidating figure if you didn't know him, but for those that knew him - he was a pussycat! When he retired from Storm Bowling Products, he had this to say:

"I'll miss the people... beginning from Mr. And Mrs. Chrisman, the people in the field, and all the wonderful professionals in Utah. When it is all said and complete, it is the people in life who touch your heart the most. The greatest honor I have received is to have been fortunate to have shared the 'field of battle' with the great folks at Storm!"


This past week Jim rolled a 623 scratch series and 241 scratch game in the Golden Agers League. That series allowed him to move from second to first on the League Leaderboard.



Family Ties came out strong, taking the first two games, dropping only the last game by 28 for a 4-1 win. Daniel Hong led Family Ties with a 621 set while Eric Snow managed 583 to pace Threadworks.

The "B" match featured the next two 4-1 teams with **Pro Approach Oak Tree** (Leonard Ruiz Jr.) taking on **Don Julio Tequila** (Gabe Garza). Pro Approach Oak Tree started the night with a huge 185-pin win and coasted to a 4-1 result, dropping only the last game to Don Julio's nice 810 effort.
