The Woman Behind Operation Freedom Paws

NORWALK — She served nine years in the Army where she learned to train dogs. Her love for animals and the plight of the wounded warrior helped her parlay her knowledge into forming Operation Freedom Paws training dogs to work with Vets and Vets to work with their dog. Her mantra: "Four paws, two feet, one team navigating life together."

Mary Cortani was nominated for CNN Heroes, people who have accomplished notable feats, and is now among the top ten nominees. Depending on votes there is a possibility of winning \$50,000 to \$250,000 for her organization.

Mary's name and position on CNN Heroes was sent to me from Donna Morales of San Jose. Donna is a longtime promoter of bowling and is well known for her tireless coordination of groups to bowl in every manner of tournament. Mary is a bowler and says she has bowled on and off most of her life and steadily the last 14 years – thanks to Donna keeping her involved in the tournaments! A 164 average bowler, Mary is a member of the San Jose USBC and the San Jose 500 Club. Born and raised in Santa Cruz she now resides in Gilroy, California.

Selection of a Vet to participate in the program is according to an application process stemming from a doctor's



reference and if chosen they must commit to the program. She says, "Every day is a heart rending experience watching the progress of the Vet with their dog." Many feel they are still in a combat zone and have lost the will to exist and for many it is the invisible wounds. The dogs keep them grounded and give them purpose. The animals come from shelters and rescue groups and Operation Freedom Paws help them navigate life together.

Operation Freedom Paws is a non-profit organization, and since 2010 has paired dogs with 80 Vets who have visible wounds such as post traumatic distress disorder. MACMONAGLE HITS 817 IN DEAF TRAVEL AT DEL RIO LANES

DOWNEY—For his vacation from bowling, Leroy MacMonagle flew to Florida ahead of Super storm Sandy and luckily during his stay Hurricane Sandy roared on past off the coast.

He was able to fly back home on Oct. 31 and few days later resumed his bowling in So. Calif. Deaf Traveling League’s stop at Del Rio Lanes. Three weeks off from bowling did not matter to him as he led the league with 817 from games of 214, 216 and 232 before slumping to a 155.

While MacMonagle was away, his Orange County lost its hold on first place and in this day’s position round contest, he tried vainly to get back to first place. It’s opponent Whittier with double whammy of Robert Audette (800) and Randy Salazar (789) beat Orange County 31-7 to stretch its lead to 7.5 points. Audette hit games of 202-176-209-222 and Salazar, 195-223- 203-158.

With MacMonagle and Audette being 1 and 2 on the day’s honor roll of 10 bowlers, Bob Jones came 9 pins short of the third 800 with his 791 from 202-201-204-184. After Salazar’s 789, Gardy Rodgers stole the show when he, after games of 158-201-174, closed his last game with 8 strikes in row for the day’s high game 233 and 766. Ed Abakumoff had roller coaster games of 160-224-155-213 for 763. Gorman Low (200-187-195-168/749) dueled with and beat (3-2) Francisco Navarro (203-177-213-151/744. A lady, Celia Salado had a 203 for the season high women’s game and the day’s high 686 lady series. Sub Marvin Sager had a 201.


Overlooked on that day is the season team high series 2194 made by Whittier trio of Audette (800), Salazar (789) and Andy Lorenzo 605. That replaces the tie scores of 2148 made by Orange County and Mid City.

MONTCLAIR — We returned to Bowlium Lanes where we saw 154 entries come out on Saturday for a fun day. The cut scores were good, +82 for the men and +26 for the women, on a medium shot this week. The Super Seniors added to the board (two men and one Woman) were Sun Sundara +78, Ed Palma +73, and Bobbie McCollum +20 for the women. Super seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 44 bowlers making it to the semi-finals.

We had one bowler that bowled this score and it was Andy Toro who gladly took the Cash. Therefore, we will estimate the Match Series at \$280 at Action Lanes. "Iron Mike" Villarreal was the last person standing for the 3-6-9. He missed on his first shot for the 3-6-9. so he will get the \$50 consolation. We will estimate the pot will be \$1,400 at Action Lanes.

In our optional doubles, finishing first were Steve Brode and Edmond Del Mundo with a 1497 for \$120. Finishing second was Steve Brode and Tim Tran with a 1458 for \$100. There was a total of \$1,270 paid out in doubles and 24 paid spots with low to cash of 1405.

After the semi-finals, the leader was Gilbert Gissendanar with a +162. Finishing in second was Emilio Flores at a +145. Emilio will sit out the first round of the top 16 Single Elim Finals. Gilbert, top seed had the honor of drawing the Match Game worth \$3,500. Gilbert drew a 132. After a review of all the scores bowled, we had three bowlers who shot that score, they were Rey Josafat Jr, MikeVillarreal, and Jeannette Chang. They will

each get/ got \$1,166. We still have four full pots and now a fifth pot started that is at \$250, so next week we will go for \$3,500 again.

This would bring us to our top 16 Match Play finals. In the first round, the seven losers were Don Quitangon, Deborah Sanders, David Matunguina, Anthony Ta, Michael Davis, Jeff Taino, and David Emrich. Each will get \$100. In the second round, the four losers were Ben Bagaosian, Kenny "King" Kwan, Chris Kelly, and Kurt Valmonte. Each getting checks of \$105.

This would get us down to the final five bowlers. The weekly horses are paying a low of \$41, Emilio Flores, to a high of \$73, Bobbie McCollum and Tony LeoGrande. In one match, the eighth seed Tony LeoGrande versus Cecilia Lung the sixteenth seed. This was another of our good scoring matches where Cecilia advancing with a 184/233 to 167/214 final. In the other match, it was Emilio Flores the second seed versus Bobbie McCollum the fifth seed. This was another one of the medium scoring matches, where Emilio continued his march through the matches in a quest to the title match and not let Bobbie advance for the second straight week. He would take this victory with a 180/233 to 150/203 to advance. Tony and Bobbie finished in fourth and fifth getting checks for \$110 each.

Emilio would open in both frames and that would give the lead to Gilbert by 7 pins. Gilbert would mark in the fourth and then open in the fifth. He would still have a six pin lead. Emilio would mark in the fifth but miss the 2 pin in the sixth. Gilbert would get a mark in the sixth, but leave the 4-6-7-9-10 split and miss all the pins. Emilio came up in the seventh and got a spare to take a slim three pin lead. Both bowlers stayed clean through the ninth frame, but Emilio was able to increase his lead to five pins. Emilio finished first and got a spare, thus Gilbert would need to double in the tenth for the victory. Gilbert left the 3-9-10 split and Emilio would finish with a 150/203 to Gilberts 147/188 and take home his first championship. He would take home \$1,000 for the victory, an additional \$1,700 for Cash and Carry, an additional \$100 for wearing his ABTA shirt, \$100 for using a Global Ball to give him a total of \$2,900. 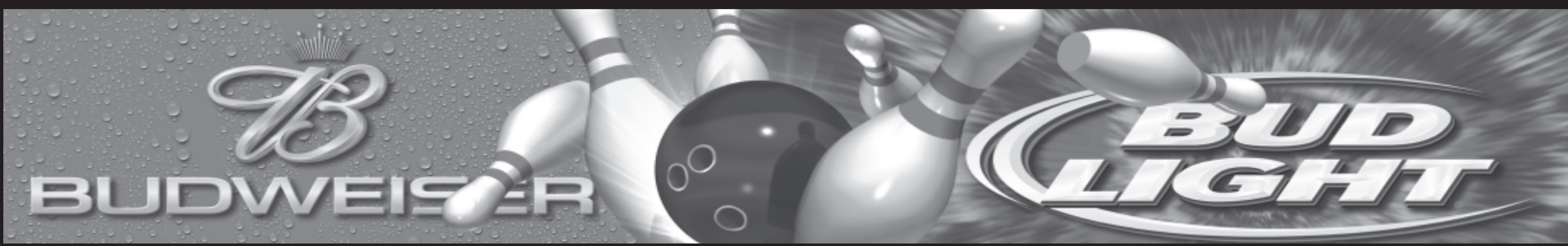
