The "Masters" and all PBA tournaments used to get great coverage in metropolitan newspapers, but in recent years coverage has dwindled until now, any PBA mention is on the "Round-Up" page...the one with the tiny agate type. We don't get the Sunday championship results in the LV Review Journal.
Surprise, surprise! We got about 3-column inches in LV on
Saturday, Nov. 19. Wowee! Thrill city! They gave the "Masters" scores from the 3rd round winners bracket and the 4th round losers bracket. (Based on other info on that page, it had been a "slow" news day.)

Here are the 3-game scores of the winners of those matches, 738, 751, 754, 736, 783, 760, 712, 682 (SIX?), 720, 690, 768, 705,

THAT, ladies and germs, IS A CROCK! Therein lies the story of what is wrong with the game today. If only PBA guys shot the numbers, it would still be ludicrous, but amateurs hung up many of those digits. Losers scores went into the mid to high 600 's, for the most part, but nearly every match was won by at least 100 -pins.
