# PBA Announces 15-Tournament 2019 PBA50/60 Tour Season Schedule

## Season to feature three majors and three new venues

CHICAGO - The Professional Bowlers Association has released its 2019 15-stop PBA50/60 Tour schedule that includes three majors and three new events. All of the PBA50/60 events are expected to be streamed live from start to finish by PBA Xtra Frame on FloBowling.

After kicking off the season with the PBA50 Johnny Petraglia Open presented by Brunswick at Maple Countryside Lanes in Clearwater, Fla., April 14-17, the season’s first major returns to Spanish Springs Lanes in The Villages, Fla., April 22-26 for the PBA50 National Championship presented by Spanish Springs Lanes and Radical.

The season’s two other majors return to Las Vegas for the USBC Senior Masters June 2-9 at Sam’s Town and the Suncoast PBA Senior U.S. Open presented by Storm June 9-14 at the Suncoast Bowling Center.

New events in 2019 will include the PBA50 Hamilton Lanes & Entertainment Center Open in Trenton, N.J., May 3-5, and two stops at Jax 60 Lanes in Jackson, Mich., the PBA50 Dave Small’s Jax 60 Open, July 30-Aug. 2, and PBA60 Dave Small’s Jax 60 Open, Aug. 3-5.

The PBA50 Tour will also make return trips to Mooresville, N.C., Brentwood, Calif., Monticello, Minn., Hammond, Ind., Anderson, Ind., and Wyoming, Mich.

There will be two other events for players 60 and over which are: USBC Super Senior Classic at Sam’s Town, May 29-June 2, and PBA60 Dick Weber Championship presented by 900 Global Aug. 4-7 at Pro Bowl West in Goshen, Ind., to close out the season.

## BVL RECEIVES LARGE DONATION FROM HEADPINZ & BOWLAND CENTERS TO SUPPORT VETERAN PROGRAMS IN SOUTHWEST FLORIDA

“There are no better people than Pat and Lisa Ciniello, who along with their great staff understand that because of those veterans who paid the price we are free to run our bowling businesses and our bowlers are free to play the sport we all love,” said BVL Board Chair John LaSpina, whose own Maple Family Centers group raised more than \$57,000 for BVL earlier this year. “Giving back and supporting our veterans is part of their DNA, and their unwavering commitment to brightening veterans’ lives sets an example for all bowling businesses to follow.”

“This just solidifies that our bowlers are huge supporters of our nation’s military veterans,” said Pat Ciniello, CEO of Bowling Management Associates, operators of the local centers. “We couldn’t be prouder of the men and women who serve our country and likewise, we can’t say thank you enough to the bowlers for their contributions to an outstanding organization like BVL. We should never forget the sacrifice our veterans made for us to make America great!”

“We’re so grateful to the owners and bowlers and HeadPinz and Bowland for their ongoing tremendous support,” said BVL Executive Director Mary Harrar. “These dollars will go directly to work helping veterans programs in southwest Florida and making a difference in the lives of local veterans.”

The six HeadPinz & Bowland centers teamed up for several events last month, including a no-tap tournament and a “Race to the Bar” promotion with local radio station 93X in Fort Myers. Bowland Centers are located throughout southwest Florida: Beacon Bowl in Naples, Coral Lanes in Cape Coral and Bowland Pt. Charlotte. HeadPinz Entertainment Centers are in Cape Coral, Fort Myers and Naples.

BVL has raised more than \$50 million since 1942 to provide recreation grants at VA hospitals and clinics throughout the country. Fund-raising events in bowling and entertainment centers occur throughout the year although many efforts are centralized around National BVL Month each November.

are:

- **Performance** – A minimum of 10 PWBA Tour titles or a minimum of five PWBA Tour titles including two majors. Minimum age is 50.

- **Ambassador** – At least one PWBA Tour title and made a major impact on the growth of the PWBA Tour. Minimum age is 50.

- **Meritorious/Builder** – Advanced the PWBA as an organization, promoted the PWBA Tour through media and must show a minimum of five years of support.

The PWBA Hall of Fame committee will be appointed by the PWBA Player Committee, with approval of PWBA stakeholders. The committee will consist of PWBA Hall of Fame members, bowling media members, and appointed board of directors from the USBC and the Bowling Proprietors’ Association of America.

Donna Adamek, Patty Costello, Dorothy Fothergill, Mildred Ignizio, Marion Ladewig, and Betty Morris in the Performance category, LaVerne Carter, Helen Duvall and Shirley Garms in Pioneer, and Georgia Veatch in the Builder category comprised the inaugural PWBA Hall of Fame class in 1995.

The most recent class was in 2003, with Anne Marie Duggan and Virginia Norton inducted in the Performance category.

After a 12-year absence, the PWBA Tour returned in 2015 through a funding agreement from the BPAA and the USBC. The 2019 PWBA Tour season will have 14 events, kicking off with the PWBA Greater Cleveland Open on April 25-27 at Yorktown Lanes.

Through 2018, there are 35 members of the PWBA Hall of Fame – 19 in Performance, 10 in Pioneer and six in Builder.
