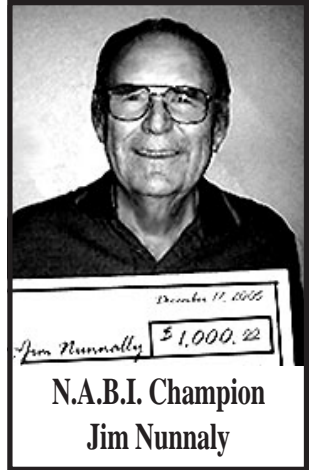
## Then There Were Nun(nally)!

# Happy New Year 2006

## Six Records Highlight 2004-05 Scoring Leaders

*900 Series, Mixed Doubles 600 Game Among Top Scores for Season*

**GREENDALE, Wis.**—The seventh approved 900 series, three more 600 men’s doubles games, the first mixed doubles 600 game and three other record scores proved to be the most notable scoring achievements of the 2004-05 bowling season announced by the United States Bowling Congress.

Darren Pomije rolled a 900 series on Dec. 9, 2004 in New Prague, Minn. That followed previous 900s by Jeremy Sonnenfeld in Lincoln, Neb., in 1997, Tony Roventini in Milwaukee in 1998, Vince Wood in Moreno Valley, Calif., in 1999, Robby Portalatin in Jackson, Mich., in 2000, James Hilton in Salem, Ore., in 2001 and Jeff Campbell in New Castle, Pa., in 2004.

The duos of John DeBenedetta/Phillip Platko, Michael Bryant/Emory Corron and Boyd Comer Jr./Mark Quinn became the 30th, 31st and 32nd such groupings with 600 games. DeBenedetta/Platko rolled their 600 in Las Vegas on Feb. 26, 2005, Bryant/Corron in Dayton, Ohio, on March 21, 2005 and Comer/Quinn in Bessemer City, N.C., on July 19, 2005.

Mike Firzak and Sue Schottke became the first mixed doubles team with a 600 game in Amherst, N.Y., on Sept. 27, 2004. The previous record was 599 by Allison Johnson and Rob Grimmitt in Oklahoma City in 1994.

Josh Becker, Beth Graham, Alex Bairos and Rick Graham, collectively called 14D\$, rolled 1,108 in Lancaster, Pa., on Oct. 8, 2004 to set the record for three men/one woman game. They beat the 1,099 by Chalupa & The Boys in Valparaiso, Ind., in 2001.

Sparta Lanes (Mike Angle, Liz Christensen and James Zucknieovich) broke the record for two men/one woman series with 2,408 in Newton, N.J., on Sept. 13, 2004. The previous standard was 2,384 by Team Matrix in St. Louis in 2001.

The final record was set by Angela Brick and Susan Jeziorski-Smith in two-woman doubles with 1,591 in Buffalo, N.Y., on Feb. 22, 2005. Brick and Carolyn Key-Reed had the old record with 1,561 in 2003.

## Tahnildaran Gets Second 300 Game In Forest Lanes’ 610 Trios League

LAKE FOREST — Yes, hot lanes 37-38 got most attention last Thursday night watching Bowlers Depot enhance their Forest Lanes’ 610 Scratch Trios League lead. Also watching Ashkan Tahnildaran repeat his previous 23 consecutive strike feat.

Yes, almost back-to-back 300s, a faulty six-pin chop/miss cost Ashkan his third 300 — settling for a 266 going into the third game with a 566 needing a 234 for the 14-team league’s first 800 series. He posted 212 for a new loop high, 778 set.

Ashkan paced Bowlers Depot, taking team series, a 2087 on games of 721, 681 and 685. Captain Jeff Carr aided with a 238/657 while Gene Plotnick (188 average) kicked in with a 235/652.

The “Depot” won 14 points putting them 3 1/2 points ahead of Team 7. Mario Marquez 277/671, Kurt Michel 204/580 and Mike Belair 268/660 held their position with a 670/1911; a safe distance from Team 10 and 2.

Team 10 made it into the top three defeating Team Four taking 12 points of a possible 17. Johnny Nguyen paced his trios with a 245/664. Mike Duong had a 229/638 while Tri Vo helped with a 216/584.

Why all the high scoring? The trios are fighting for that Storm \$5,000 title — \$1,666 per player.

Yes, Ashkan almost got another Andy Varipapa 300. Varipapa a noted trick shot artist rolled many two-game 300’s, six strikes in two consecutive games. He added them up — 12

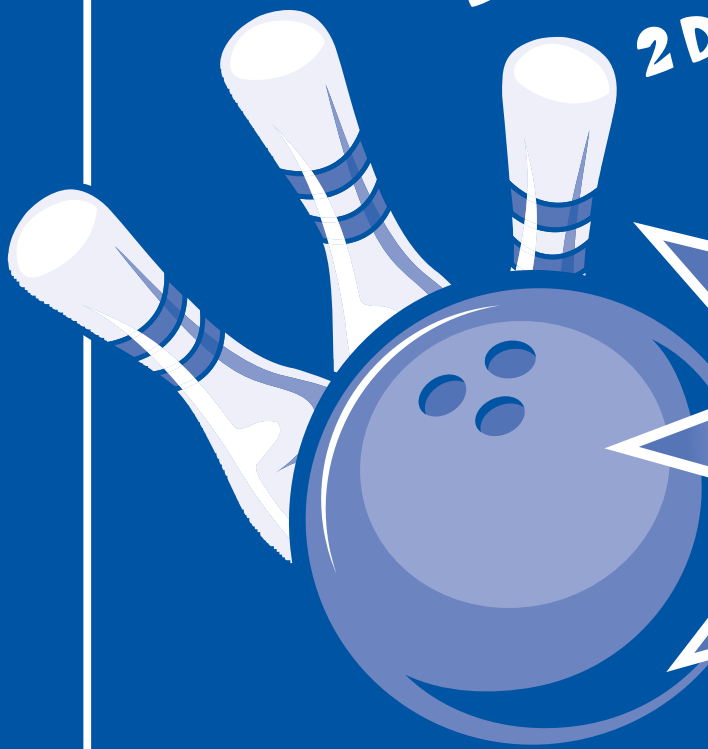

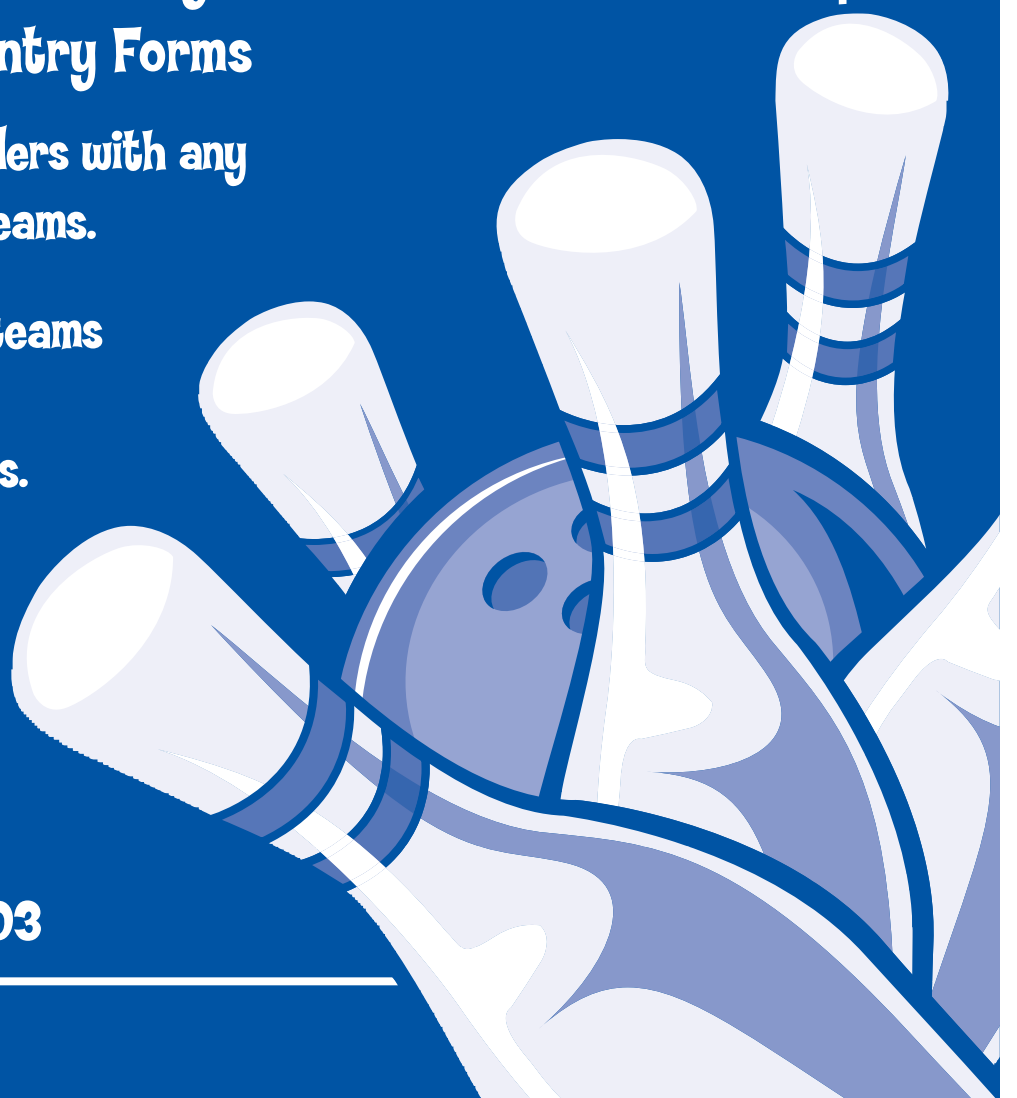

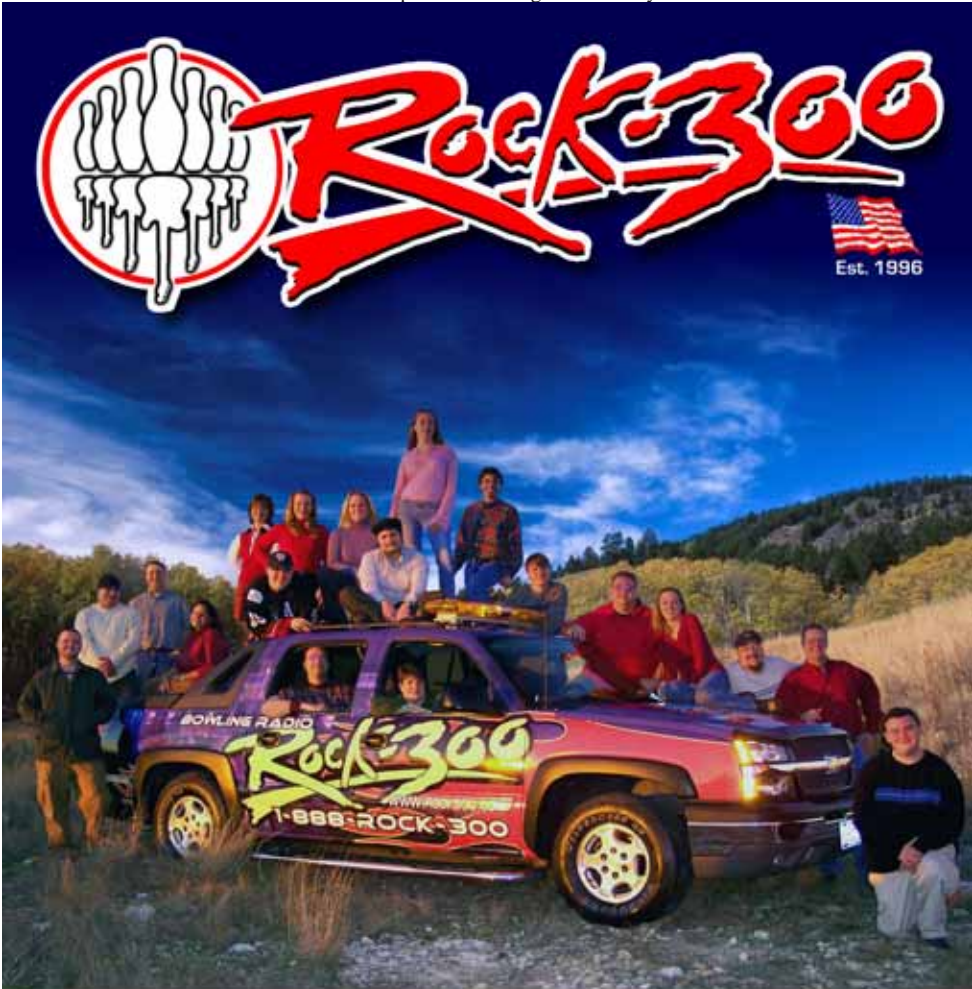
