ALL-IN SHOWDOWN RETURNS AT XTRA FRAME TOUR'S CHEETAH OPEN

FOUNTAIN BOWL—The PBA's All-In Showdown, a winner-take-all special event with a \$5,000 entry fee, will return to the program as the kickoff event for the inaugural Xtra Frame Tour event in Fountain Valley, Calif., on Friday, Jan. 20.

The second All-In Showdown of the season follows the inaugural event held during the PBA World Series of Bowling, where Tommy Jones topped a field of eight players, including Sean Rash in the final two-game match of the BowlersDeals.com All-In Showdown, 446-426, for a \$45,000 payoff.

The new Xtra Frame Tour Cheetah Open presented by Ebonite is set for Jan. 20-22, starting with practice and pro-ams on Friday plus the renewal of the All-In Showdown at 2:30 p.m. PT. The All-In Showdown, along with Saturday's qualifying and Sunday's match play rounds, will be webcast live, exclusively on PBA's Xtra Frame online bowling channel (for subscription details, visit pba.com).

Instead of the WSOB "survival" format where half of the field advanced in each round, the Fountain Valley Showdown will feature two-game, head-to-head elimination matches. Opponents and lane assignments will be decided by blind draw. Competition will be conducted on the PBA's Cheetah pattern.

The Fountain Valley version of the All-In Showdown

will be slightly different than the World Series version: while the entry fee remains \$5,000 and the winner will take the full prize fund, entries will be accepted in blocks of two, four or a maximum of eight to ensure there will be no "bye" rounds. Example: if three players enter, the third player will be placed on standby until a fourth entry is paid. If there are four entries, entries no. 5, 6 and 7 will be on standby until a capacity field of eight is achieved.

Players can enter the Xtra Frame Tour Cheetah Open on pba.com. Players can enter the All-In Showdown by calling Barb Wilt at the PBA office (206-654-6025). Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis.

GREAT BOWLING IN THE FINALS OF 47TH BOWLING WORLD CUP

JOHANNESBURG—Both the women's and men's finals of the 47th QubicaAMF Bowling World Cup in Johannesburg produced some of the finest bowling ever seen in the tournament.

The women were first up with Sandra Andersson of Sweden hitting 267 in her first game against Diandra Asbaty (USA) 217. Diandra came back to take the second game 247 to 219 so we were in for a decider. Diandra hit strike after strike while Sandra left a split in the 7th frame. Even so she finished with a 243 but it was not enough to beat Diandra's superb 279.

Diandra then moved on to play the top seed, Aumi Guerra of the Dominican Republic, so we were certain to have a two-times champion. Aumi shot 266 in her first game despite a split while Diandra never really got going and despite an all closed game finished on 201. The final game was nip and tuck all the way with first one then the other taking a slim lead.

By the 10th frame, Diandra needed to strike with her first ball to take the title but she left a 10 pin, finishing on 199 to Aumi's 202. So Aumi became only the second person ever to successfully defend the title.

She said afterwards: "I

have been so focussed on my play that I have even stayed away from Facebook! Now I am going to have lots to eat, go swimming, go to the beach and chill!"

The first match for the men was between the Ukraine's Mykhaylo Kalika and Jason Belmonte of Australia. Mykhaylo was clearly nervous and hit 203 in his first game to Jason's 237 but it was a different story in the second game when he hit 266 beating Jason's 248. So again we were into a deciding game, which Jason won by 266 to 185.

Jason then came up against Tommy Jones of the USA. The first game was high scoring, Tommy winning by 279 to 259. Again, Jason came back and won the second by 247 to 216. So yet again we needed a decider.

And what a game it was, strike for strike until Tommy opened the 8th frame, and finished on 236. It was up to Jason to close the 10th which he did in style finishing with 259 and becoming the first Australian man to take the title.

"I was a long way in the lead in 2004 in Singapore, and got knocked out early on," he said, "and again I led the field in St Petersburg in 2007 and then I lost in the final. So I was happy to go in as number two

seed this time.

"All credit to Tommy for some great bowling. He always looked as if he was going to strike. And I do sympathise as I know what it feels like to

lead the field and not win."

Jason's three game total of 765 is a new finals record, just beating the previous mark of 764 by Petter Hansen of Norway, set in Singapore in 2004.

Jeff’s talents weren’t limited to sports and he was a very talented artist as well as an aficionado of music... especially Rhythm & Blues. During the mid-60’s, any Ray Charles concert within a hundred miles had a virtual Junior Bowling All-Star Team in the audience with Jeff leading the way.

At his memorial service, one of his High School classmates described Jeff as an “unconditional friend”. He was just that... never judgmental, always supportive.

Late in life, Jeff was fortunate to finally meet his soul mate. His wife Linda brought him full circle and it was obvious that they were always meant to be together. Our thoughts are with her, his Brother Ken and nieces Michelle & Jamie as they celebrate his life.

WEST COVINA—The Christmas Event at West Covina Lanes was a lot of fun for our members. We saw 238 entries come out and support the ABTA and enjoy the Xmas Season Finale. Many gifts and prizes were given out by raffles to our wonderful members who are the best there is!

We had a semi tough shot for the tournament making the cut scores of +45 for the men and +37 for the women. The Super Seniors added to the board (2 men and 1 female) were Mike Bousquet(33), Romy Cajucom(36), and Mary Robles(25). Super Seniors are men 63 and over, and for the women you just need to be a young 55. That would give us 60 bowlers making it to the semi-finals this week.

Top qualifier man was Sean Nguon with a +154. The women was Aileen Chung with a +135. They will get a paid entry into a future regular ABTA event. Each week our top seed draws the Match Series, and this time it was worth \$686. Sean Nguon aka Esan Nase drew a 436. We had no bowlers that bowled this score during the qualifying squads. We will estimate the Match Series at \$1,000 at Cal Bowl. The last bowler for the 3-6-9 roll-off this week was William Garrett and he needed to get five 9 counts or strikes to take home the \$1,200. William was not able to pull this feat so he took home a consolation of \$50. We will add \$100 to the pot, and it will be at \$1,300 next week at

Cal Bowl.

In our optional doubles, finishing first were Sean Nguon and Angela Lung with a 1473 for \$150. Finishing second was Sean Nguon and Du Quach with 1439 for \$130. There were a total of \$1,500 paid out in doubles and 23 paid spots with low to cash of 1361.

After bowling 3 more games for the semi-finals, finishing first was Jonathan Barraca with a +161. Finishing second place to sit out the first round was Ryan Nam with a +136. Our top seed in semi-finals had the honor of drawing the Match Game worth \$3,500. Barraca drew a 234. After a review of all the scores bowled, we had one bowler who shot that score and it was a deserving and quite happy Nghiem Tran. 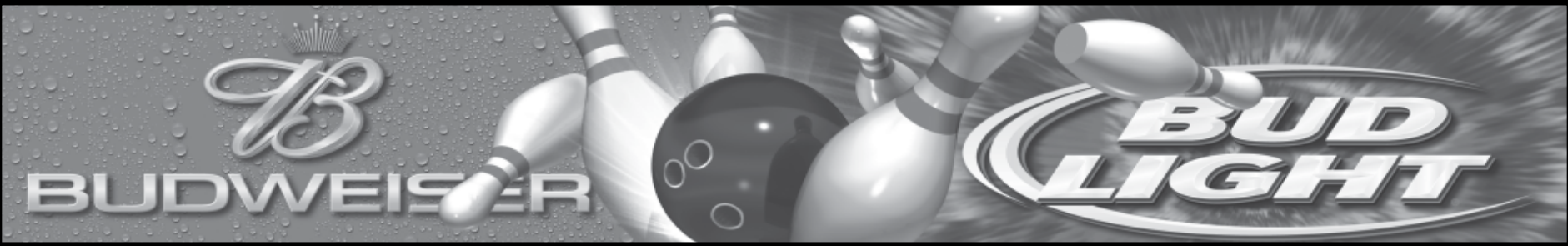

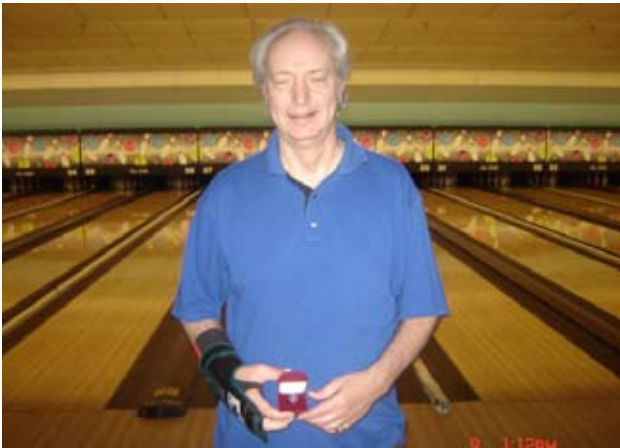

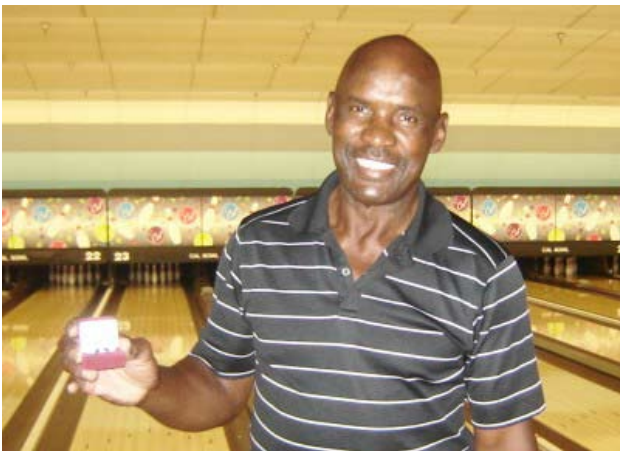
